## Geotechnical investigation works

Canterbury Road, Toorak

**Tuesday 25 May 2021**

In preparation for the installation of future rail infrastructure within the rail corridor, we will be undertaking geotechnical investigation works to assess the ground conditions.

### What we are doing

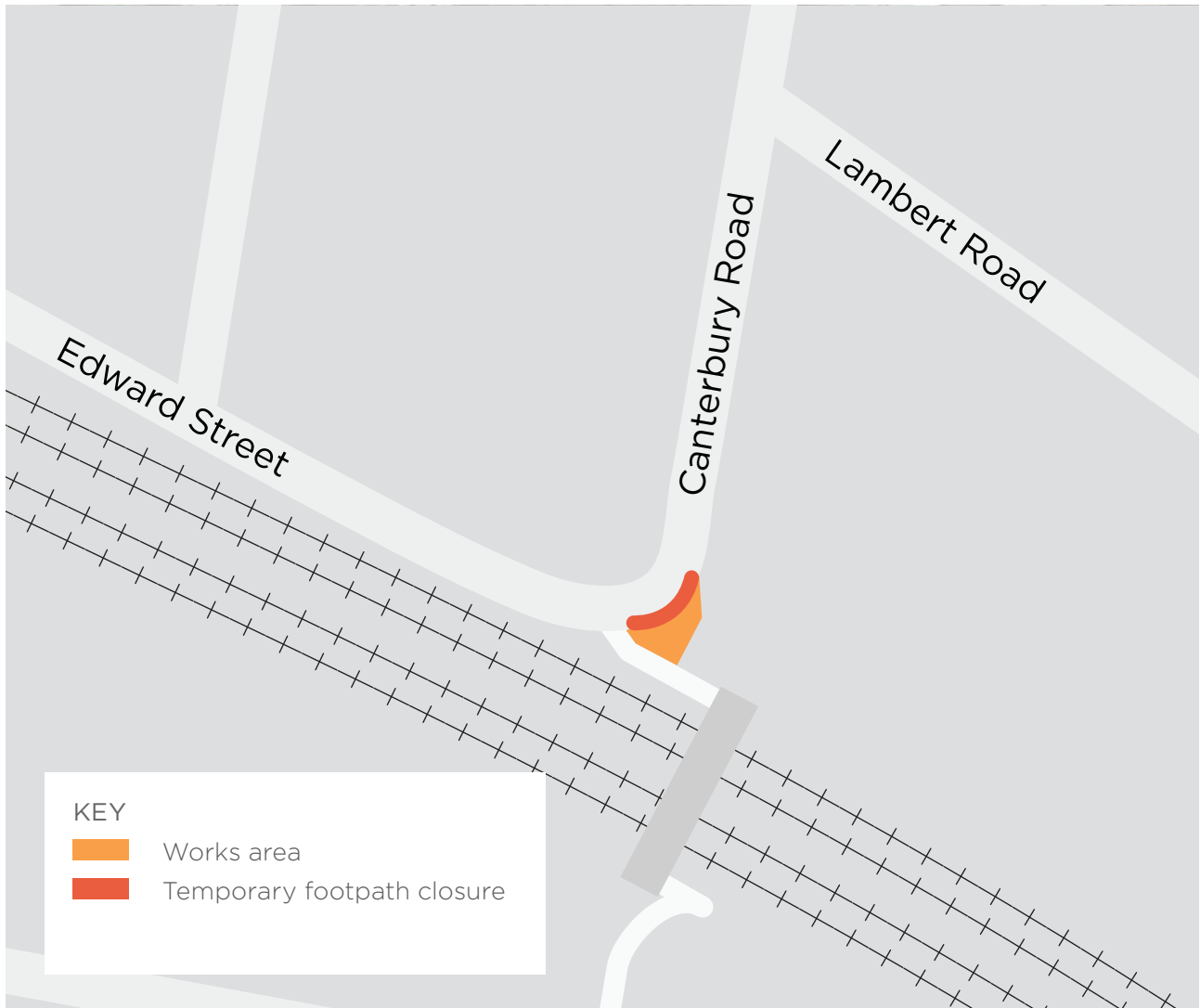
- Retrieving and assessing core soil samples to better understand ground conditions in the area
- Works will require the use of a small drill rig and crews with hand tools.

### When

- Tuesday 25 May
- 7am to 6pm.

### What you should be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and low levels of vibration
- To ensure works are undertaken safely and efficiently, a section of the pedestrian footpath between Canterbury Road and Edward Street will be temporarily unavailable during this time
- Traffic management will be in place between Canterbury Road and Edward Street to assist with pedestrian movement throughout the area. Local access will be maintained during this time.
