

# Works Notification

## Out of hours works and temporary parking removal Hopetoun Grove, South Yarra

**Thursday 22 to Monday 26 July 2021**

Further to the previously notified 24-hour rail works within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations, a temporary parking closure will be required to support works within the corridor.

### What we are doing

- Installing underground signalling cable assets and conduits
- Works require the use of a cable truck and crews with hand tools.

### When

#### 24-hour rail works

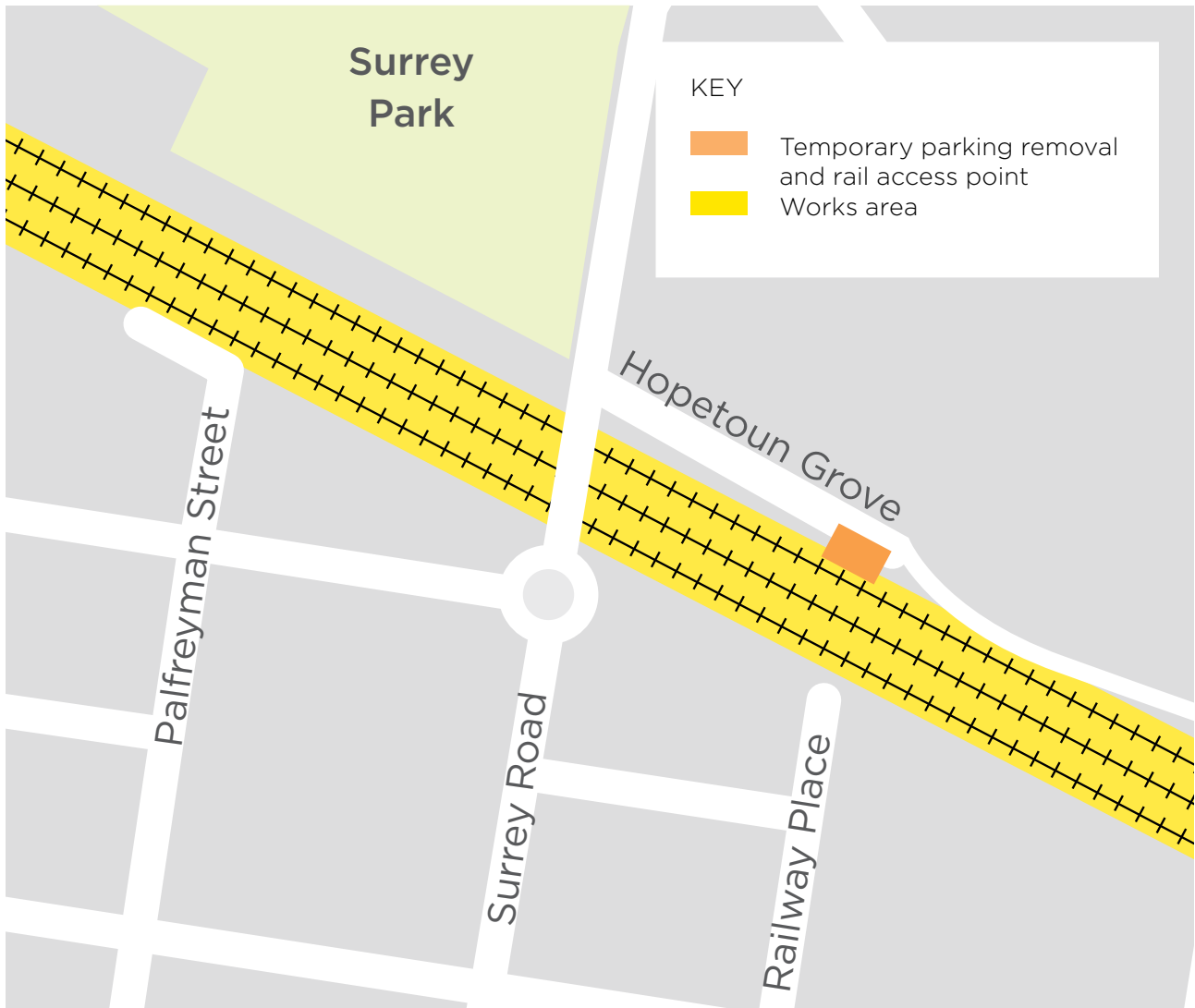
- 8pm Friday 23 to 3am Monday 26 July.

#### Temporary parking removal on Hopetoun Grove

- 6pm Thursday 22 to 7am Monday 26 July.

### What you should be aware of

- These works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise
- Three parking spots will be temporarily unavailable along Hopetoun Grove while we undertake the cable installation. Additional truck movements will be required during this time
- Traffic management will be in place along Hopetoun Grove to facilitate local vehicles from entering and exiting the road. Local residential access will be maintained during this time
- Generator-powered lighting towers are required while we complete night works. Where possible, lights will be positioned to face away from residential properties and noise reduction mats will be placed around generators.
