HIGH VOLTAGE TRANSMISSION TOWER RELOCATION UPDATE, KENSINGTON

16 - 22 JULY 2018

Further to the works notification issued on 2 July, we wish to provide an update on upcoming works during July 2018.

Due to delays caused by inclement weather, we have had to reschedule the out of hours works to relocate the high voltage (HV) towers in Kensington.

Destringing HV transmission lines

Works to destring the HV transmission lines between existing towers 34 and 35 will now take place from **9pm, Monday 16 July to 5am, Tuesday 17 July.**

Further works may be required between 9pm and 5am on the evenings of Tuesday 17 and Wednesday 18 July, dependent on weather.

HV transmission tower foundation removal

The dismantling of existing tower 34 and removal of its foundations has been rescheduled and will now take place from **7am - 5pm, Saturday 21 and Sunday 22 July.** Childers Street will be closed to through traffic between Bill Vanina Pavilion and Ormond Street on these days. Public parking along Childers Street will remain available between Bill Vanina Pavilion and Kensington Road.

These activities are expected to generate intermittent periods of medium level noise and there will be periods of low to medium levels of vibration during tower foundation removal.

Signage and traffic controllers will be in place to safely guide pedestrians and cyclists around the work areas.

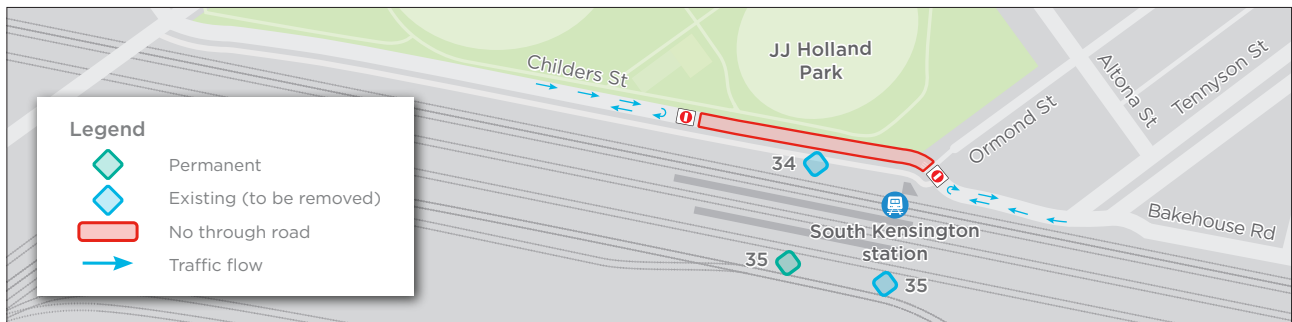
