OUT OF HOURS SERVICE INVESTIGATIONS, PARKVILLE PRECINCT MAY 2019

Please be advised out of hours service investigation works will take place in the northbound service lane on Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade from Monday 20 to Saturday 25 May 2019.

What we are doing

The northbound service lane will be closed between Haymarket Roundabout to just north of the Royal Melbourne Hospital.

Vehicle, pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained at all times with diversions in place.

Access for emergency services and to Royal Melbourne Hospital and Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre car parks will be maintained at all times.

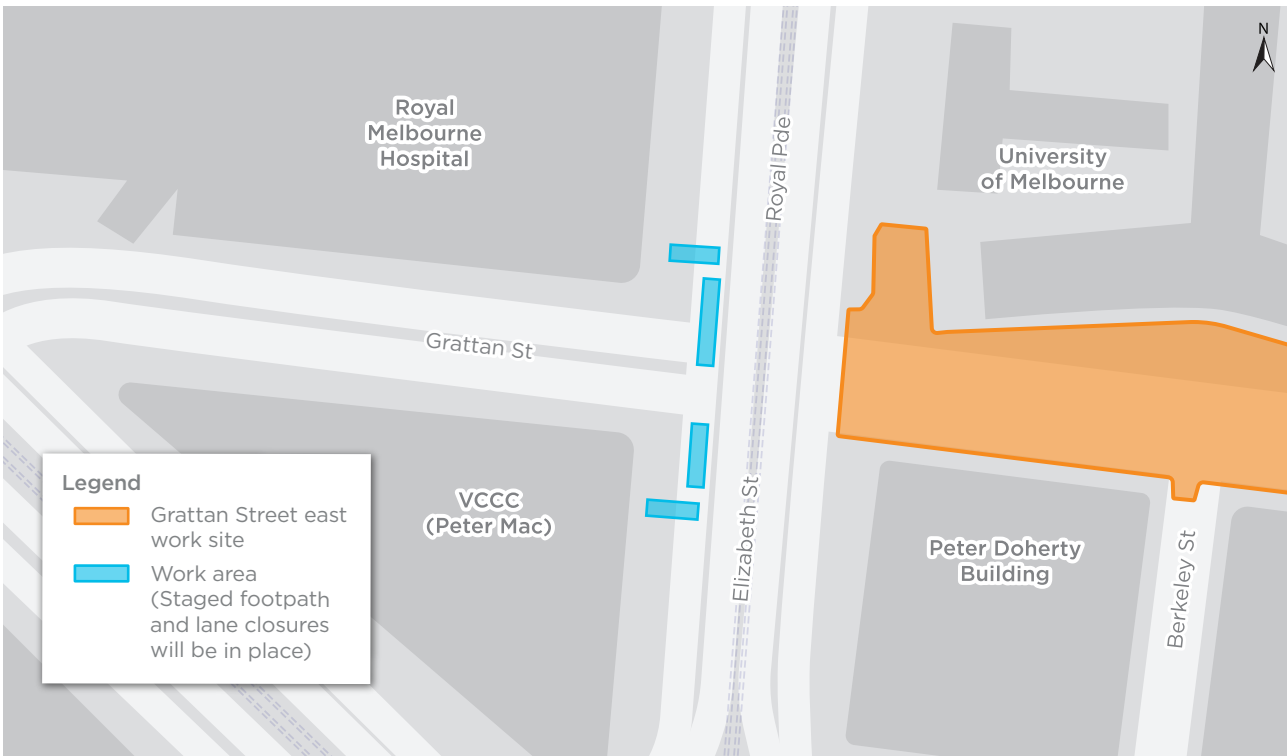
When

7pm to 7am, Monday 20 to Saturday 25 May 2019.

What to be aware of

Works will involve saw cutting and non-destructive digging (NDD) to expose the underground service and verify its location and reinstating the footpath or road.

These works are expected to generate intermittent periods of high level noise during NDD and saw cutting works. Where possible, the noisiest activities will be programmed to take place earlier in the evening to minimise impacts to the community. These works are required out of hours to reduce the impact to traffic.
