SHORT-TERM ROAD CLOSURES, BOWEN CRESCENT

FRIDAY 20 SEPTEMBER TO TUESDAY 24 SEPTEMBER

Major construction is continuing in Domain at the site of the future Anzac Station as part of the Metro Tunnel Project. The current phase of construction involves preparation for the St Kilda Road realignment.

What we are doing

Before we can realign St Kilda Road, we must prepare the adjoining road surfaces in order to connect them with the new section of road.

These works involve kerb work, excavation, drainage instalment, pavement placement, asphaltting and lighting works.

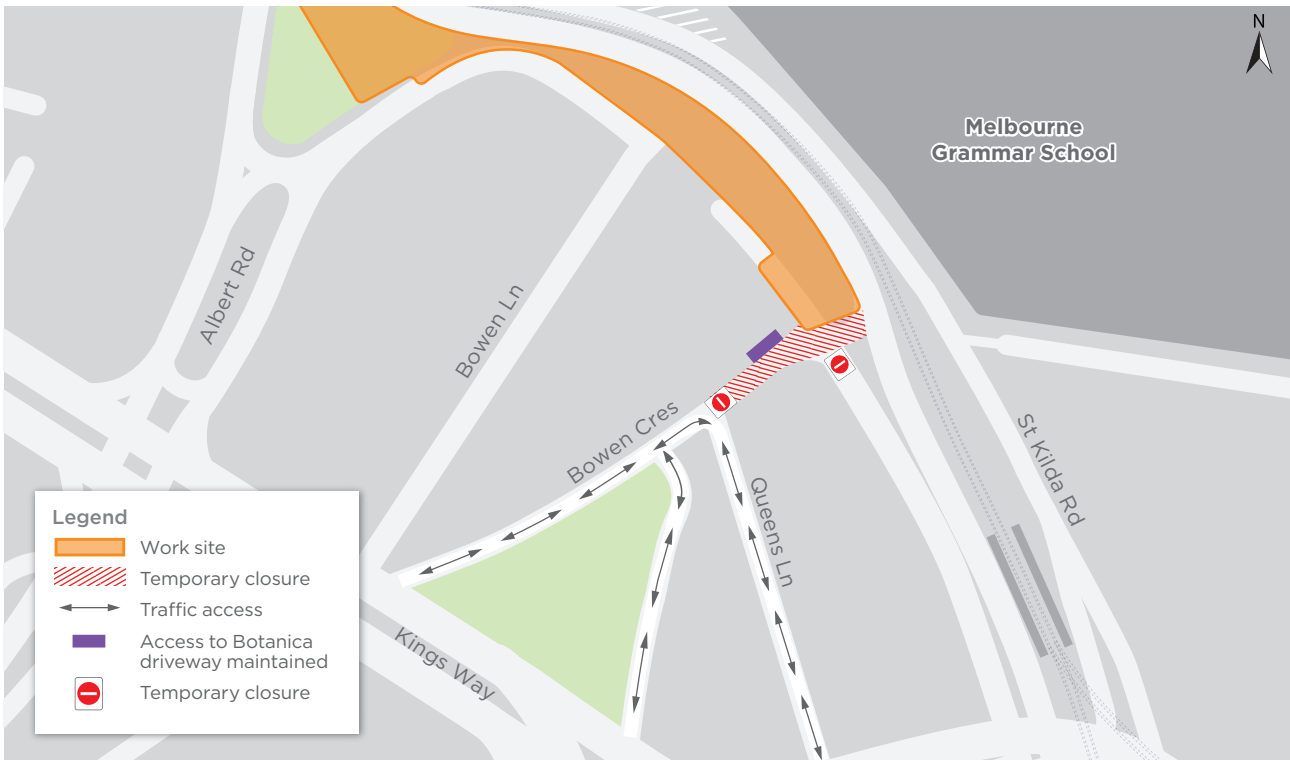
To allow for line marking and asphaltting works, Bowen Crescent between Queens Lane and St Kilda Road will be intermittently closed between Friday 20 September and Tuesday 24 September.

When

- 9am-10pm, Friday 20 and Saturday 21 September
- 9am-6pm Monday 23 and Tuesday 24 September.

What to be aware of

- Bowen Crescent will be closed between Queens Lane and St Kilda Road during our working hours
- The road will be reopened on Friday and Saturday nights at 10pm, with temporary bollards in place to assist in navigating the area
- The road will be reopened on Monday and Tuesday nights at 6pm
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, with a minor detour to Queens Lane
- Access will be maintained to the Botanica top car park and Ace car park at all times
- For the Monday and Tuesday Bowen Crescent closures, access to both Botanica driveways will be maintained with traffic controllers in place to assist.
