DRAINAGE WORKS WEST FOOTSCRAY STATION

10 FEBRUARY – 3 MARCH 2020

Major construction is continuing along the Sunbury rail corridor in preparation for the Metro Tunnel. We will soon commence installation of a new stormwater drainage pit that will service the new platform and track at West Footscray station.

What we are doing

- Delivering materials into the rail corridor
- Digging within the rail corridor using an excavator
- Installing supporting walls and pouring concrete to form the new pit
- Monitoring a manhole on Barkly Street while the works take place.

When





- Monday 10 February to Tuesday 3 March
- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and low levels of vibration
- Construction vehicles will access the rail corridor via Cross Street and Sunshine Road
- Pedestrian and traffic flow around Barkly Street will be maintained during these works, however traffic controllers will be present at times to assist with movements around the monitored manhole.
