



WORKS NOTIFICATION

GRATTAN STREET WEST STATION ENTRANCE CONSTRUCTION, PARKVILLE PRECINCT FROM LATE MAY 2020

Construction to build the station entrance adjacent to the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre on Grattan Street will commence in May 2020.

To enable station entrance construction, including piling, excavation and associated activities, Grattan Street westbound lanes, between Flemington Road and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade, will remain closed for three years.

Access for emergency services and cyclists will be maintained via a Grattan Street eastbound lane.

Works to construct the station entrance adjacent to The Royal Melbourne Hospital will commence in 2021. Further information about these works, including dates and timing, will be provided.

What we are doing

Site mobilisation (from late May)

- Installation of hoarding, fencing and pedestrian gantries around the site perimeter
- Implementing traffic changes on Grattan Street, between Flemington Road and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade, such as changes to the U-turn facility and parking
- These works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise.

Station entrance construction (from late May to early 2021)

- Piling to support the structure and enable workers to safely carry out excavation
- Once the piling works are complete, excavation equipment will dig out the top few metres of material

- Constructing a roof slab over the excavation
- Following roof slab construction, reinstatement works and further underground utility relocations will occur to enable construction of the station entrance adjacent to The Royal Melbourne Hospital
- Daily deliveries and removal of material, equipment, and plant via Royal Parade and Flemington Road
- These works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise.

When

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday (intermittent works)
- 6pm to 7am, Monday to Friday
- 24 hours, Saturday and Sunday.

What to be aware of

- Temporary fencing, signage and traffic controllers will be in place around the work sites
- Access to hospitals, including for emergency services, and businesses will be maintained at all times
- Out of hours activities will take place to minimise impacts to daytime operations of sensitive equipment at nearby facilities
- All works being undertaken will be in line with the Environmental Performance Requirements (EPRs).

TRAFFIC & TRANSPORT CHANGES

Traffic changes

- Grattan Street westbound lanes will be closed between Flemington Road and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade for three years
- The right-hand turn from Royal Parade southbound lane into Grattan Street is permanently closed to traffic. Construction vehicles are exempt
- Grattan Street eastbound lane will remain open to emergency services, and cyclists
- There will be an overnight closure of Grattan Street for general traffic between Flemington Road and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade between 7pm and 5am in late May. Access will be maintained for emergency services at all times
- To facilitate piling works, the Elizabeth Street northbound service lane, between Haymarket Roundabout and Grattan Street will be temporarily closed to traffic for up to three weeks. Further information, including timing, will be provided
- Additional intermittent overnight closures of the Elizabeth Street northbound service lane, between Haymarket Roundabout and Grattan Street, will take place on weekends in late May. Traffic management and signage will be in place to direct motorists safely around the work site.

Access to hospitals and services

- Vehicles accessing Grattan Street from Flemington Road for the drop-off/pick-up parking will be required to perform a U-turn and exit via Flemington Road
- Additional drop-off/pick-up parking for the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre is located on Elizabeth Street

- Access for deliveries to the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre loading bay on Elizabeth Street will be maintained at all times during Elizabeth Street northbound service lane closures under traffic management.

Emergency vehicle access

- Access will be maintained for emergency services at all times.

Cyclist changes

- Access for cyclists travelling eastbound on Grattan Street to Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade will be maintained under traffic control
- Cyclists wanting to travel westbound on Grattan Street to Flemington Road are advised to dismount and walk their bikes from Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade.

Pedestrian changes

- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, with some local diversions in place around the work sites.

Public transport

- Tram stop locations will remain the same
- The Elizabeth Street northbound service lane will be temporarily closed for up to three weeks to facilitate piling works. During this time, the bus route 505 will not service The Royal Melbourne Hospital/ Royal Parade stop. Further information, including timing, will be provided
- Temporary bus stop closures are currently in place on Grattan Street for bus routes 401, 402, 403. Further information is available at www.ptv.vic.gov.au.

Health and safety


The health and safety of our workers is our key priority as we continue to deliver the Metro Tunnel Project, as is supporting social distancing measures in line with current health advice.

We have strict protocols in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including enhanced industrial cleaning arrangements,


provision of personal protective equipment and measures to reduce staff contact, including staggered shifts.
