


PROJECT OVERVIEW









TOWN HALL



In late May, a new pedestrian crossing opened on Flinders Street adjacent to Hosier Lane and the Federation Square atrium.

On Wednesday 3 June, the pedestrian crossing between Federation Square and St Pauls Cathedral closed, as did the St Kilda Road left turning traffic lane onto Flinders Street westbound.

These changes will be in place for approximately two years.







ARDEN

Works at Arden Station are fast transforming the station box into a station.

14-metre high columns that stretch from the base slab to the future station's roof are being constructed in the station Box.







PARKVILLE

Permanent structure works are ongoing within the 270 metre long station box at Grattan Street east.

Construction works to build the station entrance adjacent to the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre on Grattan Street commenced in late May 2020, with site establishment works.

Grattan Street westbound lanes, between Flemington Road and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade, will remain closed for three years.










ANZAC


