

Works Notification

Out of hours works Kensington

Friday 2 July to Monday 5 July 2021

In July, we will be working out of hours within the rail corridor, installing signalling along the Sunbury Line and undertaking structural works at the tunnel entrance.

What we are doing

Signalling works

- Installing new signalling services throughout the rail corridor adjacent to McLennan Drive, involving the use of a cable truck, hand tools, elevated work platform and a crane
- This will require short term closures of some parking spaces along Bakehouse Drive (see map overleaf)

Rail corridor works

- Inspecting and adjusting sections of track throughout the rail corridor
- These works will involve the use of elevated work platforms, hand tools, non-destructive digging (NDD) truck, excavators, and deliveries to and from site
- The temporary delineation fencing that runs along the decline structure will be removed using an excavator and a crane

Structure works

- Installing structural steel at the western tunnel entrance decline structure
- These works will involve the use of elevated work platforms, hand tools and deliveries to site.

When

- 24/7 from 6pm, Friday 2 July to 7am, Monday 5 July 2021.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate periods of high level noise while using an NDD truck. All other works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise
- Machinery will utilise horns and reversing beepers to ensure safe vehicle movements
- Use of temporary light towers powered by generators within the rail corridor. Where possible, they will be positioned to face away from residential properties
- To minimise disruption to the local community and rail users, important Metro Trains Melbourne maintenance works will also be carried out at this time. For more information on these works visit metrotrains.com.au.

Travel Changes

Buses will replace trains in July to allow the 24-hour rail corridor works to take place.
