

# Works Notification

## Overnight relocatable equipment building (REB) delivery

Malvern station, Malvern

**Wednesday 14 and Thursday 15 July 2021**

Further to the 24-hour rail construction in June, works to deliver and install the REB have been rescheduled to take place overnight in July. These works will require a temporarily closure of the southbound lanes of Dandenong Road.

### What we are doing

- Installing a REB at Malvern station to house rail services equipment to run the new high capacity signalling that will be used for the Metro Tunnel
- The REB will be built offsite and delivered pre-constructed
- Setting up a crane on site near Malvern station car park to safely lift the building into place
- Delivering the REB to the site near Malvern station car park on an oversize truck
- To avoid major traffic impacts, oversized deliveries are required to occur between 1am and 5am
- The truck will reverse into site from Dandenong Road.

### When

- Wednesday 14 and Thursday 15 July
- Between 1am and 5am.

### What you should be aware of

- Traffic management will be in place to safely facilitate vehicle movement during this time.
- Traffic will be temporarily stopped on Dandenong Road affecting all southbound lanes while the truck is reversing into site. The traffic impacts may take up to 30 minutes
- The installation works are expected to generate medium levels of noise with some high-level peaks
- These works will be completed under directional lighting to ensure the safety of our workers. Every effort will be made to direct these lights away from residential properties.



### Health and safety

Metro Tunnel works are progressing safely under the current circuit breaker coronavirus (COVID-19) restrictions in Victoria.

Construction is an authorised industry and COVIDsafe Plans are in place on all our project sites. The health and safety of our workforce and community is our top priority.

Workers on all of Victoria's Big Build sites are currently required to wear face masks unless they meet any of the criteria for exception – such as a medical condition or to meet Occupational Health and Safety guidelines.

Physical distancing measures are in place, as well as increased hygiene practices.
