OSBORNE STREET OVERNIGHT EQUIPMENT DELIVERY AND DAYTIME TREE REMOVAL MONDAY 25 FEBRUARY TO TUESDAY 5 MARCH 2019

Excavation of the Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) retrieval shaft is progressing within the Osborne Street reserve and the next stage of piling is soon to commence.

As part of these works, three overnight deliveries are required to deliver oversized equipment to site.

These deliveries need to take place at night under Yarra Trams escort to minimise traffic and tram disruptions.

One delivery will require the removal of one tree from the traffic island on Osborne Street, near Toorak Road.

- Monday 25 February to Tuesday 26 February, 10.30pm to 5.30am
- Wednesday 27 February to Thursday 28 February, 10.30pm to 5.30am
- Monday 4 March to Tuesday 5 March, 10.30pm to 5.30am

Tree removal

- Saturday 2 March, 7am to 1pm

What to be aware of

- For the safety of workers, there will be some directional lighting during night works. We will position directional lighting away from residences as much as possible

- We expect night works to generate some periods of low to medium level noise
- We expect some periods of high-level noise during daytime tree removal.
