



WORKS NOTIFICATION

SHARED USER PATH CLOSURE AND OUT OF HOURS WORKS BETWEEN EPPING AND SOUTH MORANG STATIONS

1 OCTOBER TO 1 NOVEMBER 2019

Construction is continuing between Epping and South Morang stations, where new High Capacity Signalling trackside equipment and signalling technology is being installed in preparation for testing for the Metro Tunnel.

To facilitate safe access to the rail corridor and enable this equipment and cabling to be installed safely, public access to the South Morang shared user path, between Darebin Creek Trail and Pindari Avenue, will be closed as required throughout October.

What we are doing

- Installing and pulling cable from the Epping Train Depot in Cooper Street to Cooper Street Bridge and Henderson Creek drain (south of Plowman Court)
- Installing foundations for Relocatable Equipment Buildings and Location Cases at 323 McDonalds Road, Henderson Creek and within the Epping Train Depot
- Ongoing correlation works and cable pit inspections
- Works will require the use of; battery operated light towers, a cable pulling winch, a cable truck, trucks and excavators.

When

Day works:

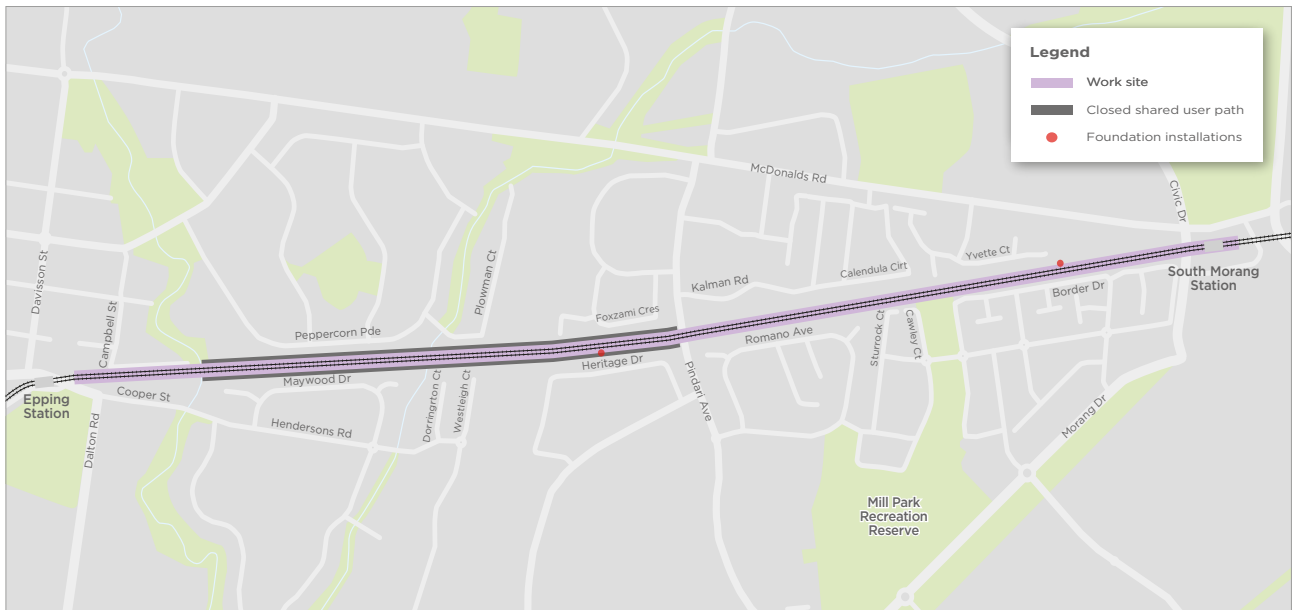
- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.

Out of Hours works:

- 8pm to 6am, Thursday to Sunday.

What you should be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise
- From 1 October to 1 November, a section of the South Morang shared user path (between Darebin Creek Trail and Pindari Avenue) will be closed to the public during day and night hours
- Traffic management will be in place, day and night, to divert pedestrians and cyclists safely around the closed shared user path
- Shared user path closures will be clearly signed
- Use of portable, battery operated light towers will be required. Where possible they will be positioned so they face away from residential properties
- For the safety of rail users and our workers, some of these activities can only be performed safely at night, when trains are not running.
