



WORKS NOTIFICATION

TEMPORARY WEEKEND CAR PARK CLOSURES RALEIGH STREET, FOOTSCRAY

28 FEBRUARY - OCTOBER 2020

Major construction is continuing along the Sunbury rail corridor in preparation for the Metro Tunnel. To enable the installation of new power, communications and signalling infrastructure into the rail corridor, we are temporarily closing the southern Raleigh Street car park to public traffic.

What we are doing

- The southern Raleigh Street car park will be temporarily closed and used for delivery and storage of construction materials
- The site will also be used as an access point for construction vehicles into the rail corridor.

When

- The car park will be closed from 6pm Friday to 5am Monday each week from Friday 28 February until early October
- Please note that the car park will be open to public traffic at all other times.


What to be aware of

- Up to 40 spaces at the southern Raleigh Street car park will be temporarily closed to facilitate these works
- Please note that the car park on the northern side of Raleigh Street will remain open
- These works are expected to create medium levels of noise from construction vehicle movements and material unloading
- There will be an increase of construction vehicles travelling on local roads to access Raleigh Street. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist construction vehicle and pedestrian movements around the site
- Temporary lighting will be used during night works. Where possible they will be positioned so they face away from residential properties.
