



## WORKS NOTIFICATION

### UPDATE - LA TROBE STREET TOWER CRANE INSTALLATION MARCH 2020

Major works on the Metro Tunnel are underway to support construction of the new State Library Station at the northern end of Swanston Street in the CBD.

The eastbound lane on La Trobe Street, between Elizabeth and Swanston streets, will remain closed until 8pm Sunday 22 March during tower crane installation works.

#### What we are doing

- Installing a tower crane at the La Trobe Street site.

#### What to be aware of

- The eastbound lane closure on La Trobe Street, between Elizabeth and Swanston streets, will remain in place as tower crane installation works continue until 8pm on Sunday 22 March. The lane will be reopened if works are completed before this time.
- Little La Trobe Street will be closed for one day to motorists, cyclists and pedestrians during the assembly of the crane boom. This work will take place between 7am and 6pm on Saturday 21 March 2020 (or Sunday 22 March, if required)

- Local access for residents and businesses will be maintained at all times (refer to map)
- Works are expected to generate medium levels of noise.

#### When

##### La Trobe Street eastbound lane closure and tower crane installation

- 24h until 8pm Sunday 22 March 2020.

##### Little La Trobe Street closure and crane boom assembly

- 7am to 6pm on Saturday 21 March (or Sunday 22 March, if required).
