OUT OF HOURS BRIDGE BEAM INSTALLATION WORKS OSBORNE STREET AND SOUTH YARRA SIDING RESERVE

SATURDAY 4 TO MONDAY 6 JULY 2020

In mid-June, the beams that will form the foundation structure of the Osborne Street bridge were delivered to site. The beams will be installed over the rail corridor, while trains are not running on the Sandringham line over a weekend 24/7 period.

What we are doing

With deliveries and preparation works complete, the installation of the new Osborne Street bridge beams will be completed over one weekend, with 24/7 works taking place while the Sandringham line is not running. Works to install the bridge beams will include:

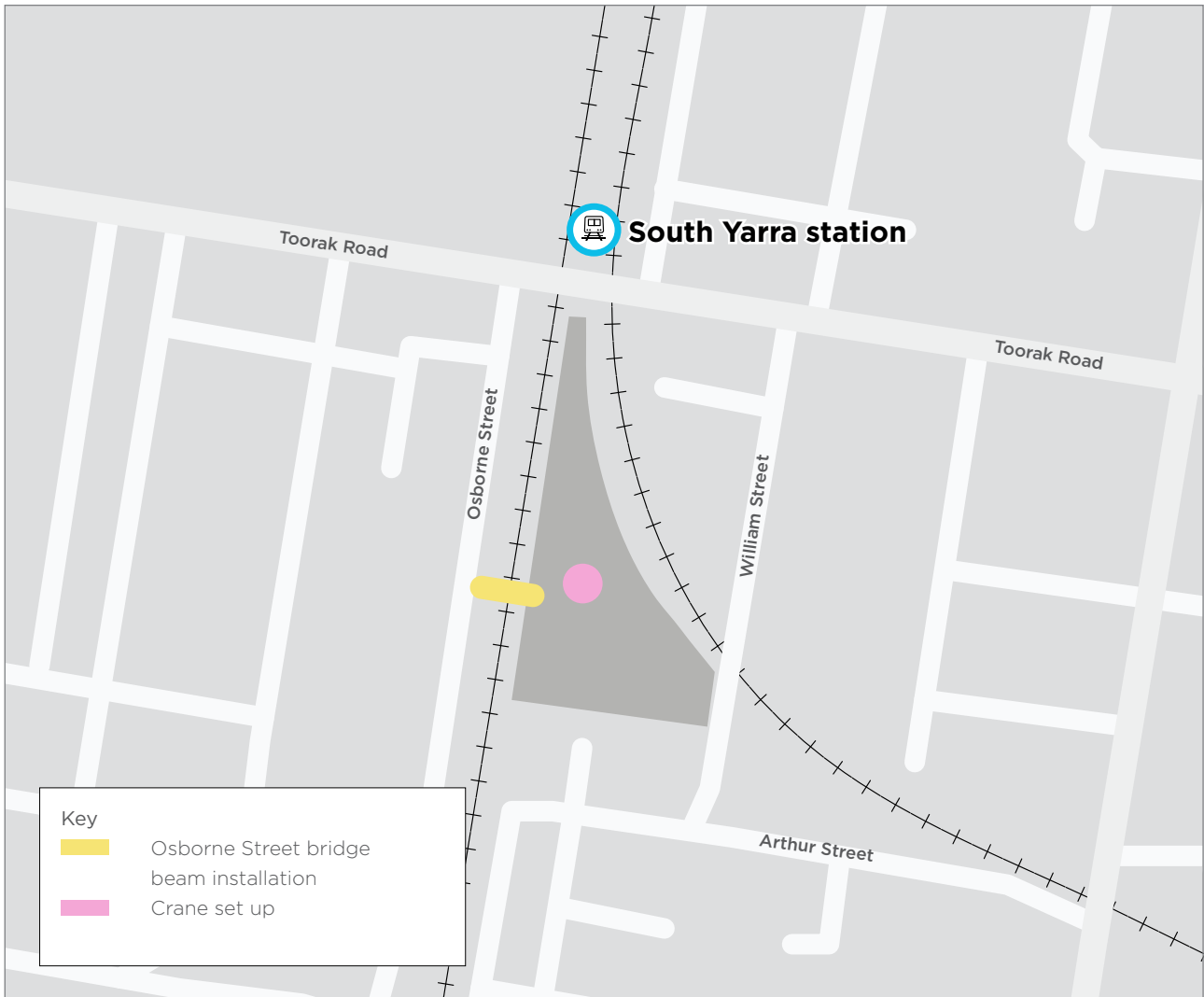
- Delivery and setup of a crane inside the South Yarra Siding Reserve
- A crane will be in operation as the steel structural supports and beams of the bridge are lifted into place
- Once the steel is fitted into place, it will be bolted together to ensure the structural integrity of the bridge
- A concrete base will be poured on top of the beams to complete the base structure.

When

- 5am Saturday 4 July until 7am Monday 6 July.

What to be aware of

- A crane and concrete pump will be delivered to site to assist with the bridge beam installation, both will travel along Arthur Street and William Street to access the South Yarra Siding Reserve site
- Most of the works are expected to generate medium levels of noise. High level noise is expected while the bridge beams are fitted into place and bolted together
- Works will be completed under directional lighting powered by generators to ensure the safety of our workers. Every effort will be made to direct these lights away from residential properties.



Health and safety


The health and safety of our workers and the community is our key priority as we continue to deliver the Metro Tunnel Project, as is supporting physical distancing measures in line with current health advice.


We have strict protocols in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including enhanced industrial cleaning arrangements, provision of personal protective equipment and measures to reduce staff contact, including staggered shifts.
