



WORKS NOTIFICATION

24/7 RAIL WORKS RAIL CORRIDOR, BETWEEN TOORAK AND CAULFIELD STATIONS

WEDNESDAY 22 TO TUESDAY 28 JULY 2020

As part of the Metro Tunnel works to construct the eastern tunnel entrance in South Yarra, we will be undertaking 24/7 rail works at Armadale station and along the rail corridor. Works will involve installing cable conduits at Armadale station and maintenance works to service pits throughout the rail corridor between Toorak and Caulfield stations.

What we are doing

- Installing cable conduits at Armadale station and along the rail corridor
- Maintenance works on previously installed rail service pits within the rail corridor between Toorak and Caulfield stations
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) to locate and expose underground service and cables (NDD uses pressurised water to break up and vacuum soil, exposing assets and services underground without causing damage)
- Works will involve an elevated work platform, NDD truck and hand tools.

When

Rail corridor works (24/7 works)

- 8am Friday 24 to 3am Monday 27 July.

Parking removal on Cheel Street

- Wednesday 22 to Tuesday 28 July.

What to be aware of

- Additional truck movements will be required during the 24/7 works, as materials are delivered from our rail access points at Edward Street and the Malvern Woodyard to the work sites
- A temporary site shed will be setup next to Armadale station on Cheel Street to provide essential worker amenities while we complete works at Armadale station
- These works are expected to produce medium levels of noise with some high level peaks
- Generator-powered lighting towers are required to complete these works during the night. Where possible, these will be positioned to face away from residential properties
- There will be traffic management and lane closures in place along Dandenong Road while we complete works on the rail corridor. Access to nearby businesses and residential properties will be maintained
- Please note that works will not impact train services. Visit www.ptv.vic.gov.au for more information.
