



# Works Notification

## Road Improvement Works St Kilda Road, Domain Precinct

**Tuesday 22 September, 2020**

Major construction is continuing in Domain at the site of the future Anzac Station as part of the Metro Tunnel Project.

### What we are doing

- Performing road improvement works on the surface of St Kilda Road, in front of The Domain building (1 Albert Road)
- Works will be undertaken to fix the dip in the road, which has been causing loud noise as trucks drive over this section of road
- A temporary solution had been recently applied to reduce noise in the interim. These works will provide a more permanent fix for the road surface.

### What you should be aware of

- During the works, the temporary closure of St Kilda Road northbound is required between Kings Way and Albert Road between 9am and 4pm
- A detour will be in place via Kings Way and Park Street (see map)
- Bowen Crescent and Bowen Lane will also be temporarily closed at the intersection with St Kilda Road, however local access will be maintained

- Residents exiting the Botanica building's St Kilda Road driveway will turn left at Bowen Lane and left onto Kings Way
- Traffic control will be on site to monitor the closure
- Cyclists will be required to dismount and walk their bikes between Bowen Lane and Albert Road South along St Kilda Road northbound.

### When

Tuesday 22 September 2020, 9am - 4pm

A closure may be required on Wednesday 23 September if weather restricts works being completed on Tuesday.

### Health and safety

The Metro Tunnel Project is a critical state infrastructure project under Stage 4 restrictions, allowing work to continue with strict health and safety measures in place.

The health and safety of our workers and the community is our key priority and we have measures in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including temperature screening, additional protective equipment including masks, daily health screening of workers, enhanced cleaning, staggered shifts and break times, and physical distancing. Our workforce numbers across Victoria's Big Build have already been significantly reduced to support directions from the Chief Health Officer, and we are continuing to manage the number of staff and visitors attending our worksites.
