

Works notification

Scrubber installation Little La Trobe Street

October 2020

Works to deliver a scrubber (ventilation system) to the Little La Trobe Street site will take place on Friday 16 October under a road closure.

What we are doing

- Oversized delivery of a scrubber to Little La Trobe Street using a truck, tower crane and hand tools
- Lifting the scrubber from the road into the Little La Trobe Street site using cranes
- Working from Literature Lane with an elevated works platform
- Installing a scrubber, acoustic enclosure and site sheds on the western section of the Little La Trobe Street site.

What you should be aware of

- During these works, Little La Trobe Street and Literature Lane will only be accessible to motorists via Elizabeth Street (refer to map)
- During these works, a section of Literature lane will be temporarily closed to pedestrians and motorists (refer to map)
- Local access for residents and businesses will be maintained at all times
- Traffic management will be in place, to safely guide pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists around the work area

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise
- The ventilation system, acoustic enclosure and elevated site sheds will be in place for about two years.

1am to 2pm, Friday 16 October 2020

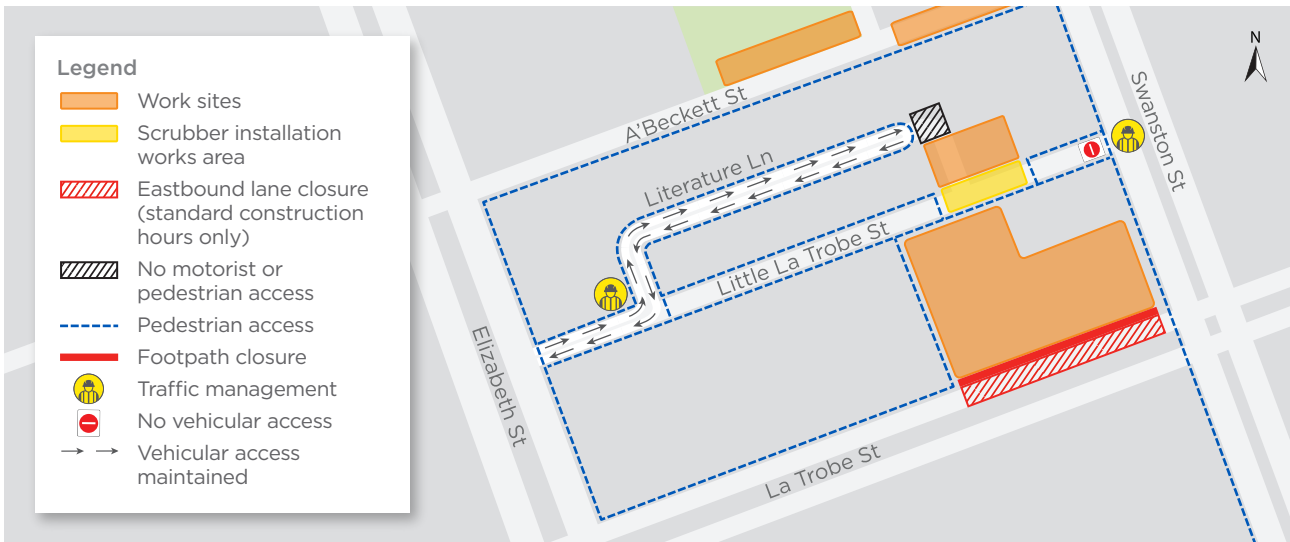
7am to 2pm, Monday 19 October 2020

6pm to 10pm, Monday to Fridays (as required), ongoing until November 2020.

Metro Tunnel Project works are progressing safely under the current Second Step restrictions in metropolitan Melbourne.
