

Works Notification

Drainage investigation works Beatty Avenue, Armadale

Tuesday 22 June 2021

We wish to advise that due to wet weather, works to investigate the condition of drainage on Beatty Avenue have been rescheduled to Tuesday 22 June. This notification provides a summary of rescheduled works on Beatty Avenue.

What we are doing

- Investigating underground drainage services beneath Beatty Avenue using CCTV equipment
- Lowering a camera into the rail service pits and capturing images to help evaluate the condition of drainage
- Removing and reinstating drainage pit lids using hand tools.

What you should be aware of

- Works are expected to generate low levels of noise
- Some parking along Beatty Avenue will be intermittently closed while we complete these works. Traffic management will in place and access will be maintained for local traffic during these times.

When

- 7am to 6pm, Tuesday 22 June.

Health and safety

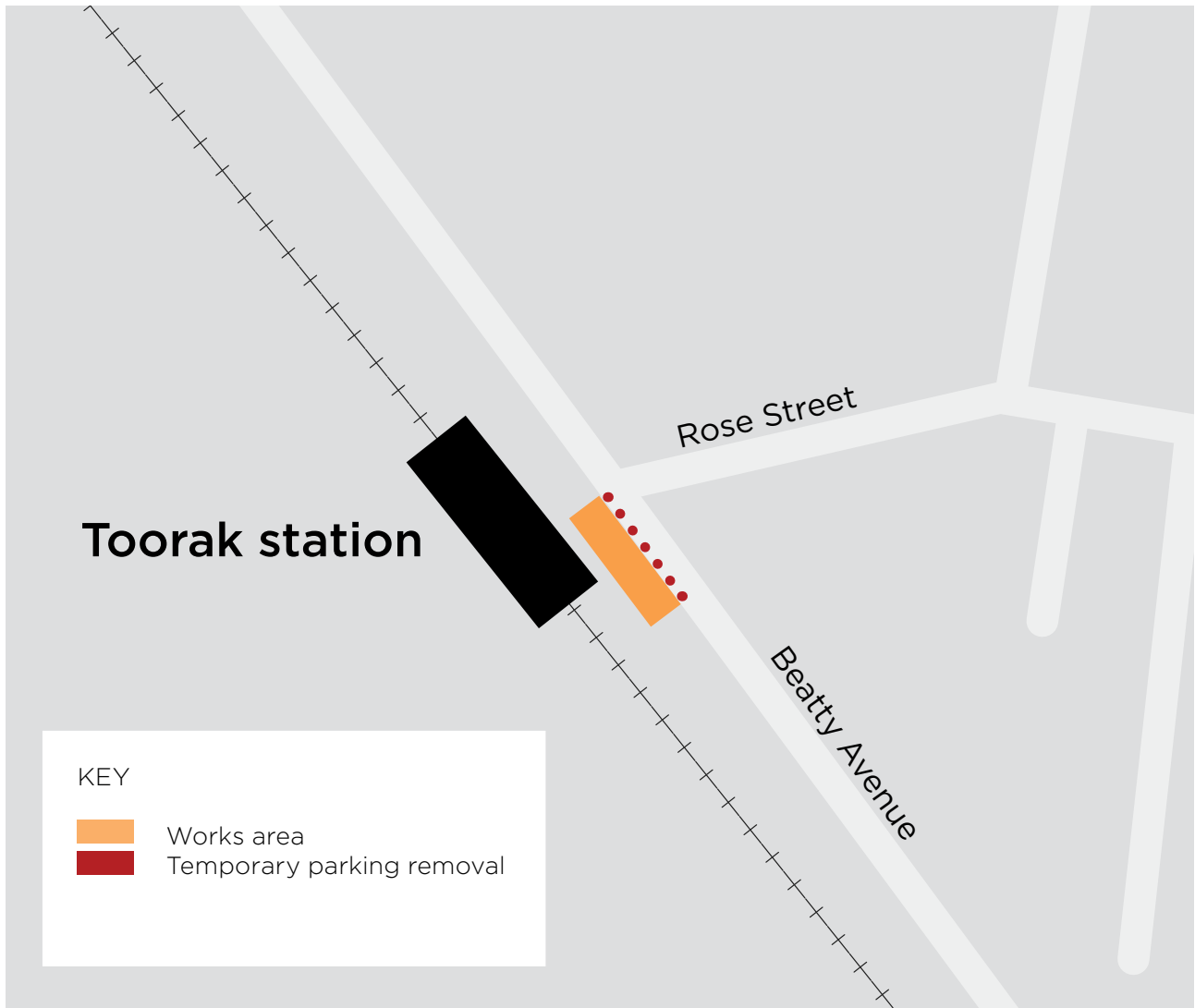
Metro Tunnel works are progressing safely under the current circuit breaker coronavirus (COVID-19) restrictions in Victoria.
