
STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS



- Environment Effects Statement included public exhibition of concept design
- Incorporated Document requires Development Plans to:
 - Address surface works and underground areas
 - Include site layout, architectural, landscape and public realm plans and elevations including lighting, signage, pedestrian access, bicycle access and other ancillary facilities
 - Demonstrate design is in accordance with Urban Design Strategy and Environmental Performance Requirements
- Existing approved Eastern Portal Development Plan
 - Public display of detailed design from Friday 6 April to Friday 27 April 2017
 - Ministerial approval on 1 July 2018
- Since approval, detailed design development has continued.
 Eastern Portal CRG has had presentation as the design developed.
- Proposing amended Development Plan seeking comment on changes in August 2021



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE - CYP

CROSS PASSAGE CONSTRUCTION



- Four of the six cross passages between Anzac Station and Eastern Portal are now complete
- Waterproofing and lining works continue at Cross Passage 23 and Cross passage 21
- Excavation has now commenced at the first of the cross passage sites between Anzac and Town Hall Station
- Work on these new cross passages runs from Anzac Station site.

TRACK FOUNDATION

Concrete invert construction



- 780 metres (25%) of the eastbound tunnel invert has been completed
- The team continues to work from the Anzac Station end of the tunnel back towards Eastern Portal pouring the concrete
- The Westbound tunnel invert work will commence once Eastbound is complete.

- Additional truck movements required along Arthur and William Street while RIA undertake 24-hour works






Osborne Street June 2021 PM2.5






Osborne Street June 2021 PM10






