WORKS NOTIFICATION

OVERNIGHT DELIVERIES

WEDNESDAY, 19 DECEMBER TO FRIDAY, 21 DECEMBER

In preparation for works in January 2019, we will begin delivering additional machinery and equipment to the South Yarra Siding Reserve worksite.

Oversized deliveries are required to be transported along major arterial roads at night under VicRoads escort, to minimise traffic, tram and bus disruptions.

What we are doing

Three large piling rigs will be delivered to the South Yarra Siding Reserve at night, with a vehicle escort

- The trucks will travel south down Chapel Street and then turn right onto Arthur Street
- The trucks will park on Arthur St and the piling rigs will be unloaded and delivered to the reserve
- Once unloaded, the trucks will turn right into William Street, and exit the site east-bound on Toorak Road.

When

The deliveries will take place between 1am and 5am in the evening between Wednesday, 19 December and Friday, 21 December.

What to be aware of

- There will be medium levels of noise as the piling rigs are unloaded and driven into the reserve
- For the safety of workers, there will be some directional lighting during this time. We will position directional lighting away from residences where possible.
