PARKING AND TREE REMOVAL WILLIAM STREET, SOUTH YARRA **MONDAY 4 MARCH**

Three on-street trees and three car parking spaces on William Street will be removed to enable the upcoming demolition of the existing William Street Bridge and construction of structural supports for the new bridge.

What we are doing

Parking removal

- Three permit car parking spaces in front of 17 and 19 William Street will be temporarily removed until 2022
- William Street residents may be eligible for alternative parking nearby - please contact the Metro Tunnel Project Information Line on 1800 105 105 for more information.

Tree Removal

- Three on-street trees in front of 8 and 15 William Street will be removed
- An arborist and fauna expert will assess the trees prior to removal
- Work to remove the trees will involve:
 - sawcutting and excavating the concrete around the trees
 - using an elevated work platform, chainsaws and excavators to remove the trees
 - mulching the removed trees using a woodchipper
- Every effort has been made to minimise the number of trees to be removed. Two trees will be replaced for every tree removed by the project.

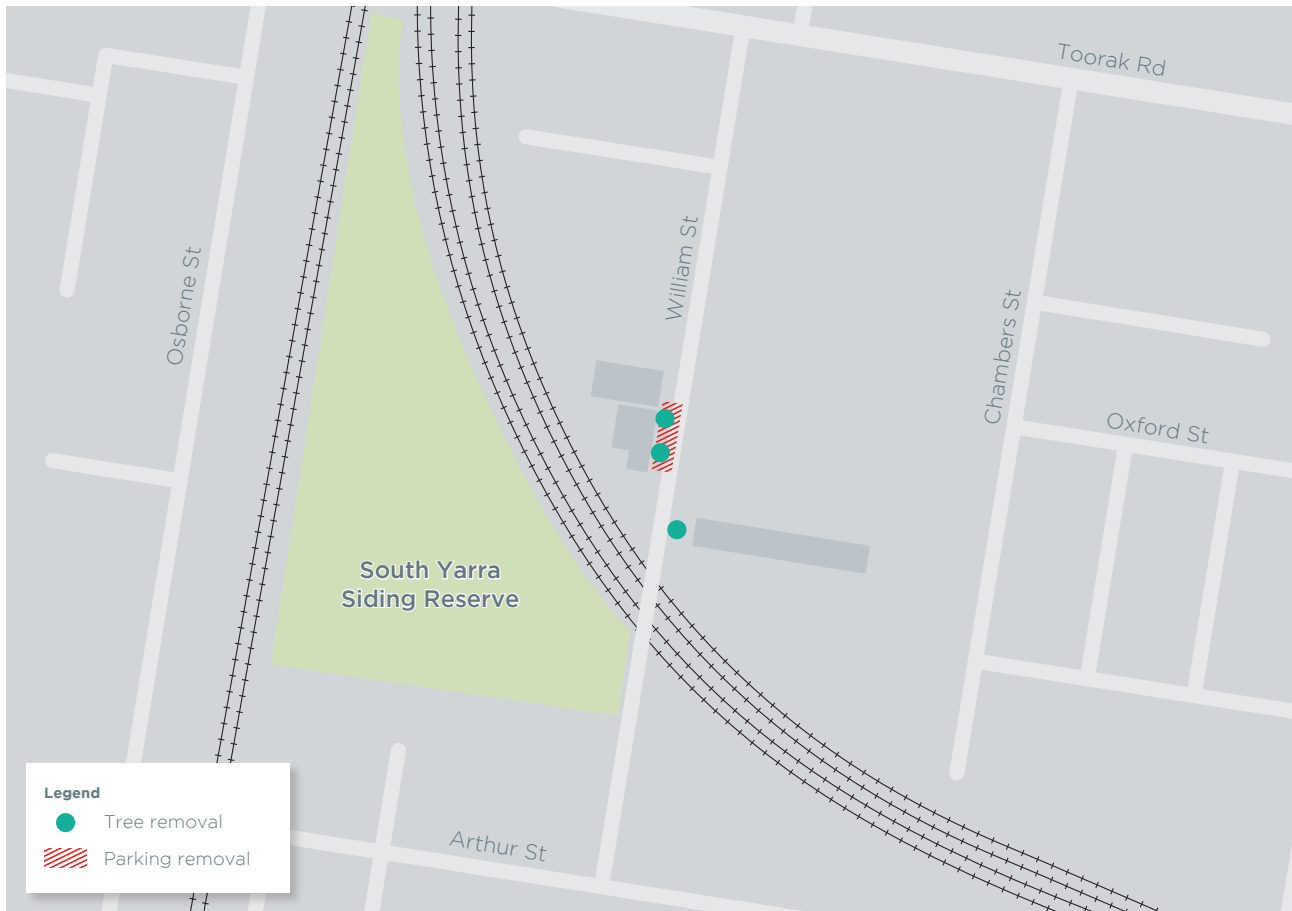
When

What to be aware of





- Traffic controllers will manage the safe flow of vehicles and pedestrians while the trees are being removed
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise, with intermittent periods of high levels of noise.
