OUT OF HOURS WORKS STATE LIBRARY PRECINCT LATE AUGUST - NOVEMBER 2019

Further to the August construction update distributed this month, we wish to advise you of additional out of hours works in your area. Major works on the Metro Tunnel are underway to support construction of the new State Library Station at the northern end of Swanston Street in the CBD.

Service scanning works

Franklin Street between Elizabeth Street and Swanston Street

What we are doing

- Service scanning, surveying and using CCTV trucks.

When

- 8pm Sunday 25 August to 5am Monday 26 August
- 10pm Monday 26 August to 5am Tuesday 27 August
- 10pm Tuesday 27 August to 5am Wednesday 28 August.

What to be aware of

- These works need to be carried out at night to minimise impacts to traffic
- These works are expected to generate low levels of noise
- Franklin Street will be closed between Elizabeth Street and Swanston Street. Local access will be maintained
- Access to businesses and residential buildings will be maintained at all times
- Traffic management will be in place to safely guide pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists around the work areas.

Oversized beam deliveries

Franklin Street between Stewart Street and Swanston Street

What we are doing

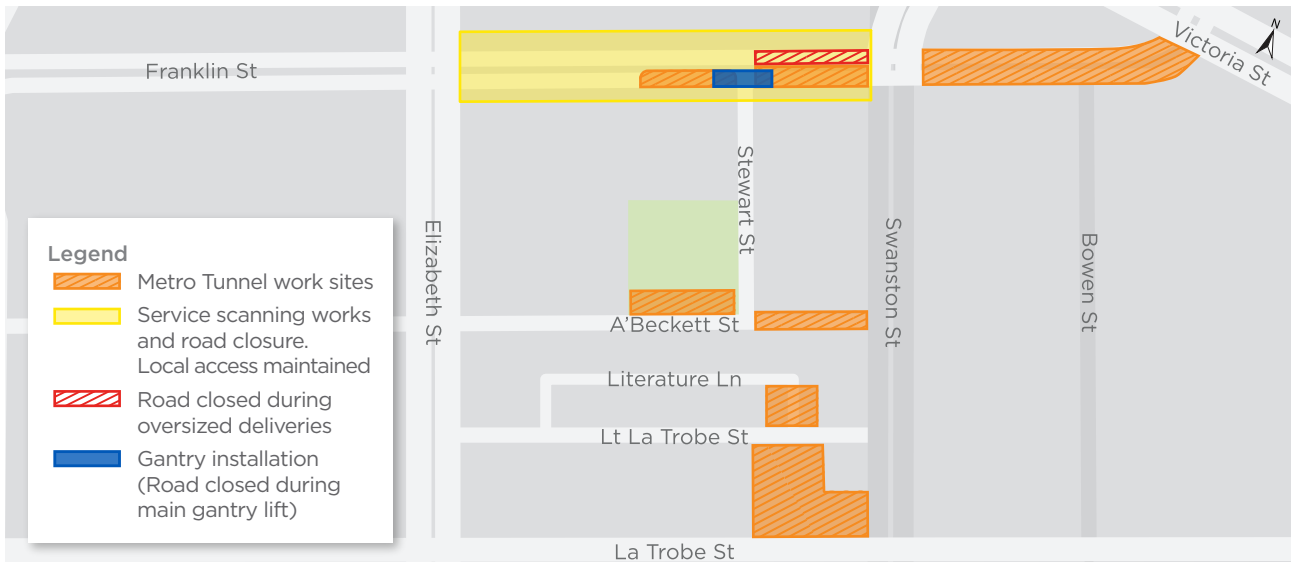
- There will be oversized deliveries to the Franklin Street West shaft site to deliver large sections of structural steel for the acoustic shed and deck.

When

- 11pm Thursday 29 August to 5am Friday 30 August.

What to be aware of

- These works need to be carried out at night to minimise impacts to traffic
- The steel will be lifted directly off the truck using a crane and placed into position
- These works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise
- Local access for residents and businesses will be maintained at all times
- There will be no through access for motorists to Swanston Street travelling eastbound on Franklin Street
- Traffic management will be in place to safely guide pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists around the work areas.

Gantry installation

Franklin Street west site

What we are doing

- Preparatory works will take place on Franklin Street near Stewart Street to install footings, stairs and cladding during day shifts. Out of hours works will be required to complete the main gantry lift.

When

- From 10pm Sunday 8 September to 5am Monday 9 September 2019.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise
- Stewart Street will be closed at the intersection of Franklin Street. Access to Stewart Street will be maintained via A'Beckett Street
- Traffic management will be in place to safely guide pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists around the work areas
- Local access for residents and businesses will be maintained at all times.

Acoustic shed installation

Franklin Street west site

What we are doing

- There will be acoustic shed materials delivered to the Franklin Street West shaft site
- Works to complete the acoustic shed will include structural works, cladding, power and lighting installations.

When

- 7am to 10pm Monday to Friday, commencing Tuesday 10 September until November 2019
- 7am to 3pm, Saturdays until November 2019.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate low levels of noise
- The acoustic shed will minimise noise, light and dust during tunnelling activities
- Local access for residents and businesses will be maintained at all times
- There will be no through access for motorists to Swanston Street travelling eastbound on Franklin Street
- Traffic management will be in place to safely guide pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists around the work areas.
