## WORKS NOTIFICATION

### SITE ESTABLISHMENT CHAPEL STREET, SOUTH YARRA **WEDNESDAY 16 OCTOBER TO EARLY 2020**

As part of the ongoing Metro Tunnel works in South Yarra, the project will temporarily use the vacant land located at 402 Chapel Street as storage space for materials and equipment to support construction of the tunnel entrance.

#### What we are doing

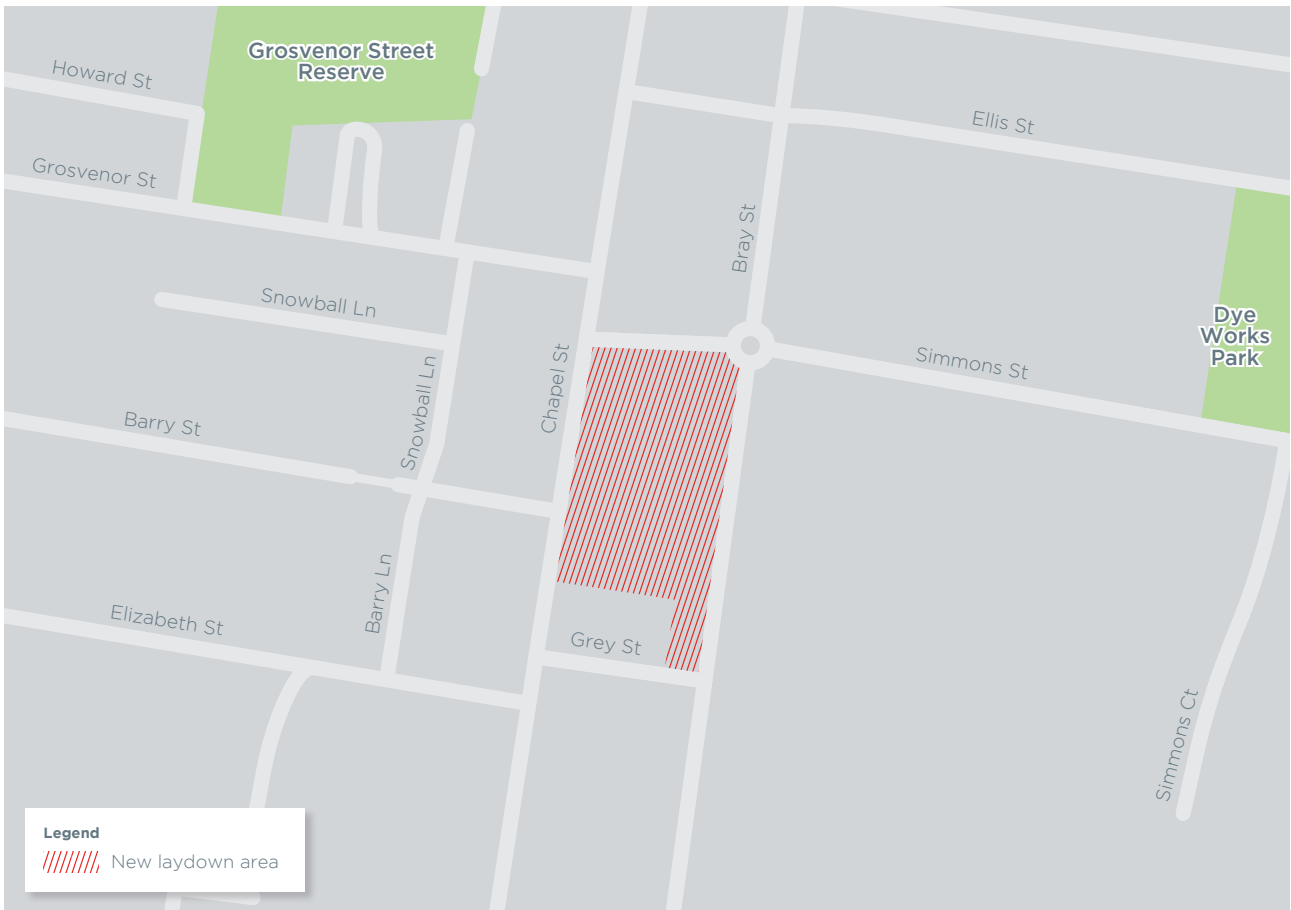
- Levelling the ground area at 402 Chapel Street so that equipment and materials can be safely stockpiled
- Securing the area with temporary fencing, installing lights and creating a safe entry and exit point for vehicle movements.

#### When

- From Wednesday 16 October to early 2020
- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays
- There will be some instances where the site will be accessed 24/7 during times of increased construction activity.

#### What to be aware of

- Additional truck movements will be required as materials are delivered to and from site along Chapel Street
- A small shed will also be installed on site, so work crew and security have access to amenities
- There will be low level noise associated with the new lay down area.
