



WORKS NOTIFICATION

OVERNIGHT WORKS CHAMBERS STREET, SOUTH YARRA **MONDAY 2 TO THURSDAY 5 MARCH**

Recently, steel which will be used to support the new tunnel decline structure was delivered and lowered into the rail corridor overnight. In early March, a second delivery of steel will arrive via Chambers Street and will be lowered into the rail corridor while trains are not running.

What we are doing

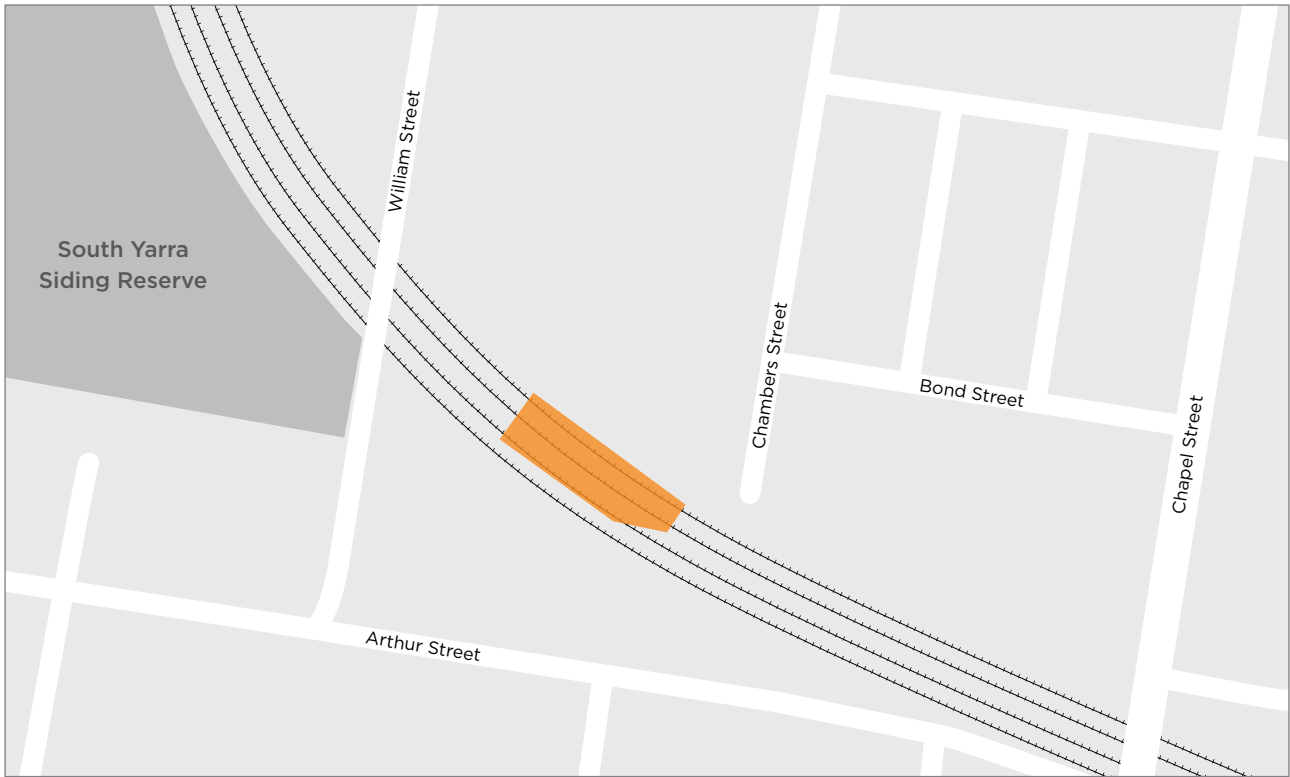
- Delivering a crane to site during normal construction hours, which will be used to lower steel into the rail corridor
- Delivering steel to site via Chambers Street during normal construction hours
- Lowering steel into the rail corridor, while trains are not running overnight
- The steel will then be used to create the new tunnel decline structure during normal construction hours.

When


- Out of hours works will take place from Monday 2 to Thursday 5 March
- Works will begin after the last passenger service each evening and will cease before the first passenger service each morning.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium to low levels of noise
- These works will be completed under directional lighting to ensure the safety of our workers. Every effort will be made to direct these lights away from homes
- Additional truck movements along Chambers and Bond streets as the steel is delivered to site.
