



## WORKS NOTIFICATION

### TUNNELLING, FLINDERS QUARTER TUESDAY 3 MARCH 2020

The third Town Hall Station roadheader will commence tunnelling within the Flinders Quarter shaft in early March 2020.

#### What we are doing

Roadheaders are massive excavating machines fitted with a mounted cutting head which will mine out the caverns for both State Library and Town Hall stations.

Tunnelling will involve:

- Excavating using a roadheader and excavator
- Shotcreting using a shotcrete rig
- Rockbolting using a drilling machine
- Delivering concrete and removing spoil using a crane and trucks
- Using equipment such as a scrubber (ventilation system) at the surface
- A generator will also be used as a temporary power supply until late March. A long-term power supply will then be connected.

#### When

7am to 10pm, Monday to Sunday.

#### What to be aware of

- There will be regular vehicle movements to deliver concrete and remove spoil from the Flinders Quarter site
- An acoustic enclosure is currently being constructed over the shaft and scrubber, which will reduce the impacts of noise and dust generated during tunnelling works once completed.
