Out of hours rail works

Rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations

Friday 30 April to Friday 7 May 2021

As part of works to connect the new Metro Tunnel to the existing eastern corridor rail lines, we will undertake works within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations, including one weekend of 24-hour works while trains are redirected.

What we are doing

Rail corridor works

- Maintenance on previously installed underground services and pits including installing signalling cable assets and underground cable conduits within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations
- Geotechnical investigation to understand the ground condition along the rail corridor
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) is required to locate and expose underground services. NDD uses pressurised water to dig and then vacuum up the soil to expose assets and services underground without damaging them
- Works will require the use of elevated work platforms, generators, a NDD truck, a hi-rail crane, a hi-rail excavator and crews with hand tools.

Relocatable equipment building (REB) works

- Foundation and underground service works for the REBs located at Railway Place, Toorak, Malvern and Caulfield stations will continue until mid-2021
- New drainage, cable conduits, signalling and services infrastructure will be installed
- These works will require the use of an excavator, a NDD truck, a dumper truck, a concrete truck, construction vehicles, trenching equipment and crews with hand tools
- Further information about installing the REBs will be provided closer to the building delivery date.

When

24-hour rail works including REB works at Toorak and Malvern stations

- 8pm Friday 30 April to 3am Monday 3 May.

Geotechnical investigation along the corridor and REB works at Railway Place and Caulfield station

- 24-hour works will take place from Friday 30 April to Monday 3 May
- Works will continue to progress during normal construction hours 7am to 6pm from Monday 3 to Friday 7 May.

Temporary parking removal on Wilson Street, South Yarra and Kooyong Road, Armadale

- Thursday 29 April to Friday 7 May.

Temporary parking removal on Osment Street and Beatty Avenue, Armadale

- Thursday 29 April to Monday 3 May.

Health and safety

Works on the Metro Tunnel project are progressing with strict COVIDsafe plans in place. The health and safety of our workforce and community remains our top priority. What to be aware of

Rail corridor works (24-hours)

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise with some high-level peaks. Where possible, higher impact works will be scheduled to take place during the day
- Additional truck movements will be required during the out of hours works, as materials are delivered to work sites from our rail access points at Osment Street and the car park near Malvern station
- Generator-powered lighting towers are required while we complete night works. Where possible, lights will be positioned to face away from residential properties and noise reduction mats will be placed around generators.

Traffic Management and parking removal - Wilson Street, South Yarra and Kooyong Road, Armadale

- Some parking along William Street will be temporarily unavailable until Friday 7 May to provide safe access

- Traffic management will be in place during this time.

Traffic Management and parking removal - Osment Street and Beatty Avenue, Armadale

- Some parking along Osment Street and Beatty Avenue, Armadale will temporarily be unavailable until Monday 3 May to provide safe access during the 24-hour rail works
- To ensure works are undertaken safely and efficiently, the south-bound lane-way of Beatty Avenue will temporarily change into a one-way street during this time
- Traffic management will be in place at all times to safely facilitate local traffic
- Vehicle access to local businesses and residential properties will be maintained during this time.
