

Works Notification

24-hour rail corridor works Between South Yarra and Caulfield stations

Friday 23 to Monday 26 July 2021

As part of works to connect the new Metro Tunnel to the existing eastern corridor rail lines, we will undertake 24-hour works within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations while trains are redirected.

What we are doing

Rail corridor works

- Constructing overhead structure foundations, installing signalling cable assets, retaining walls, underground cable services and conduits within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) is required to locate and expose underground services. NDD uses pressurised water to dig and then vacuums up the soil to expose assets and services underground without damaging them
- Works will require the use of elevated work platforms, generators, a NDD truck, a hi-rail crane, a hi-rail excavator, concrete pumps and crews with hand tools.

- 8pm Friday 23 to 3am Monday 26 July.

What to be aware of

Traffic impacts

- Additional truck movements will be required during the 24-hour rail works. Materials will be delivered to work sites from our laydown site and rail access points at 402 Chapel Street, Hopetoun Grove, Malvern Woodyard and Edward Street.

Hopetoun Grove, South Yarra

- A section of car park along Hopetoun Grove will be temporarily unavailable while we install the signalling cables near the rail access point
- Traffic management will be in place at all times to facilitate local vehicles entering and exiting the road.
- Further information about traffic impacts along Edward Street will be provided closer to the date.

Edward Street, Toorak

- Temporary parking and road closures will be in place along Edward Street to ensure deliveries to the rail access point are undertaken safely and efficiently
- Traffic management will be in place along Edward Street to facilitate local vehicles entering and exiting the road. Local residential access will be maintained during this time
- Further information about traffic impacts along Edward Street will be provided closer to the date.

Dandenong Road, Armadale

- A temporary single lane closure on a section of Dandenong Road will be required to facilitate a concrete pump for the overhead structure foundations
- Traffic management will be in place while we undertake these works and access to nearby local business and residential property will not be impacted.

Light and noise impacts

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise with some high-level peaks. Where possible, higher impact works will be scheduled to take place during the day
- Generator-powered lighting towers are required while we complete night works. Where possible, lights will be positioned to face away from residential properties and noise reduction mats will be placed around generators.

Works on the Metro Tunnel project are progressing with strict COVIDsafe plans in place.
