

Works Notification

Out of hours works within the rail corridor Between South Yarra and Caulfield stations

September 2021

As part of the Metro Tunnel rail corridor upgrades, nightly works will take place throughout September to install signalling cables within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations from 9pm until the first passenger train.

What we are doing


- Installing signalling cables within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations
- Works will involve a cable truck and crews with hand tools.

When

- Nightly, 9pm to 5am from Tuesday 14 September to Thursday 16 September
- Nightly, 9pm to 5am from Sunday 19 September to Thursday 23 September
- Nightly, 9pm to 5am from Sunday 26 September to Thursday 30 September.

What you should be aware of

- These works are expected to generate low levels of noise
- Additional truck movements will be required during this time. Materials will be delivered to the rail access points at Malvern Woodyard and the parking near Malvern station
- Generator-powered lighting towers may be required while we complete these works. Where possible, lights will be positioned to face away from residential properties and noise reduction mats will be placed around generators
- For the safety of rail users and our workers, these activities can only be performed when trains are not running
- In late September and early October, we will undertake 24-hour rail works across two weekends within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations. Detailed information on these works will be provided closer to the date.



Health and safety

The Metro Tunnel has been designated a critical state infrastructure project under the latest restrictions. Work is continuing safely with strict COVIDSafe plans in place and we'll continue to comply with all directions from the Chief Health Officer.

We are managing the number of staff attending our worksites, as well as implementing preventative measures to ensure community safety.

Safety measures across the site include temperature screening, additional protective equipment including masks, daily health screening of workers, enhanced cleaning, staggered shifts and break times, and physical distancing.
