

Works Notification

Temporary partial road closure of Normanby Road Normanby Road, Caulfield

Thursday 23 September to Friday 24 September

Works to install the relocatable equipment building (REB) at Normanby Road have been rescheduled to commence overnight on Thursday 23 September.

What we are doing

- Installing an REB at Normanby Road near Caulfield station to house rail services equipment that will power bigger, more modern trains
- The REB will be built offsite and delivered to the site pre-constructed
- A 130 tonne crane will be set up on Normanby Road to safely lift the building into place within the rail corridor
- The REB will be delivered to site on an oversize truck where it will be lifted into place
- The truck will travel via Dandenong Road, turn into Normanby Road and drive into site, where the REB will be unloaded by crane.

When

Temporary partial road closure and parking removal on Normanby Road

- 7am Wednesday 22 September to 7am Friday 24 September.

Delivering and installing the REB

- Between 10pm Thursday 23 September and 5am Friday 24 September.


What you should be aware of

Traffic changes

- The temporary parking and road closure of Normanby Road will take place where the crane will be set up, between Smith and Station streets
- Detours will be in place between 7am Wednesday 22 September and 7am Friday 24 September
- Traffic management will be in place to facilitate local traffic movement and pedestrian access along Normanby Road at all times.

Noise

- Works are expected to generate medium levels of noise when the crane is operating
- Overnight works will be completed under directional lighting to ensure the safety of our workers. Every effort will be made to direct these lights away from residential properties.



Health and safety

The Metro Tunnel has been designated a critical state infrastructure project under the latest restrictions. Work is continuing safely with strict COVIDSafe plans in place and we'll continue to comply with all directions from the Chief Health Officer.

We are managing the number of staff attending our worksites, as well as implementing preventative measures to ensure community safety.

Safety measures across the site include temperature screening, additional protective equipment including masks, daily health screening of workers, enhanced cleaning, staggered shifts and break times, and physical distancing.
