GRADUATE CAREERS ON TRACK WITH MELBOURNE METRO

Graduates will have the opportunity to kick-start their careers on Victoria's largest ever public transport project with the Melbourne Metro Rail Authority today launching a graduate career program.

The Melbourne Metro Graduate Program will begin in early 2016 and give recent graduates the opportunity to work alongside the industry experts who are designing and delivering the city's newest underground rail line.

Opportunities will be offered across a range of disciplines, including engineering, legal, communications, human resources and planning and environment.

Participants will take part in a structured learning and development program over 18 months, incorporating a number of rotations within the Melbourne Metro Rail Authority.

With the demand for rail industry expertise at an all-time high in Australia, the program will provide a new generation of graduates with experience in the rail industry and help address the sector's skills shortage.

Melbourne Metro is a city shaping project that will deliver twin nine-kilometre rail tunnels and five new underground stations at Arden, Parkville, CBD North, CBD South and Domain, freeing up space in the City Loop for the benefit of other rail lines.
