INSTALLATION OF GALVANIZED STEEL TROUGHS - PALFREYMAN STREET

TUESDAY 23 TO FRIDAY 26 JULY 2019

As part of the Metro Tunnel works to construct the eastern tunnel entrance in South Yarra, we will be installing steel troughs along the rail corridor, near Palfreyman Street, South Yarra. The troughs will hold power and communication cables for the upgraded train lines.

What we are doing

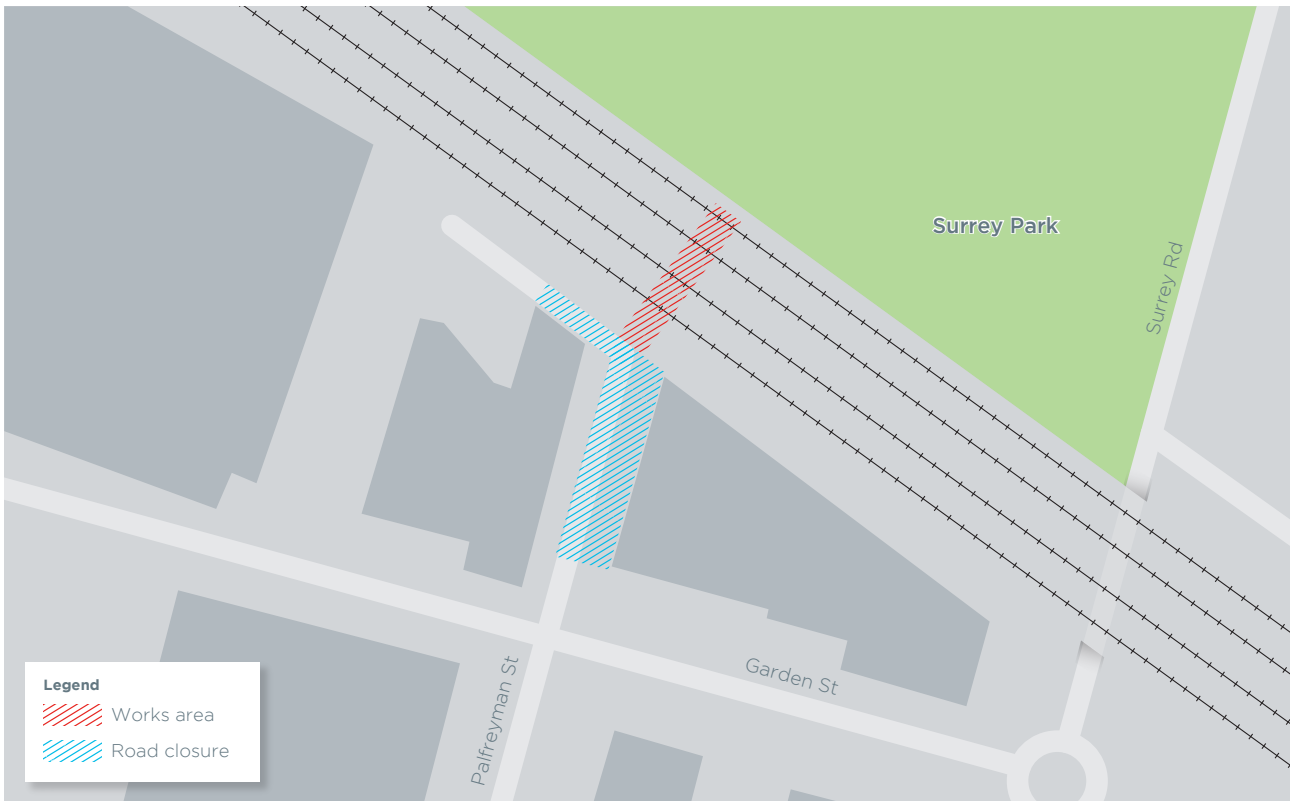
- Excavation, drilling and digging to install the troughs
- Pouring concrete, to provide support for the new troughs
- These works will involve a small work crew with an excavator, drill and hand tools.

When

- Tuesday 23 to Friday 26 July
- 7am to 6pm.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise
- Some parking on Palfreyman Street will be temporarily removed during this time. Access to nearby businesses and residential properties will be maintained.
