



WORKS NOTIFICATION

TRAFFIC CHANGES IN THE DOMAIN PRECINCT 22 – 28 OCTOBER 2019

Works to realign St Kilda Road as a part of the Metro Tunnel Project continue in Domain at the site of the future Anzac Station. To facilitate these works, traffic changes and full closures of St Kilda Road are required.

What we are doing

There will be a number of traffic changes as the project transitions St Kilda Road into its new configuration. This will allow the finishing works of the realignment. These works include barrier arrangement, removal of equipment and plant, traffic signal modification and line marking.

When

Albert Road North reopening

- Wednesday 23 October
- Albert Road North will now reopen on Wednesday 23 October. Four days earlier than anticipated
- In order to fully reopen the road, the lay down area and traffic barriers will need to be removed
- While these barriers are removed, traffic controllers will be in place to manage access to buildings
- Please note, angle parking on Albert Road North will remain closed and reopen on Monday 28 October.

Albert Road North closure

- Friday 25 October, 9am to 4pm
- Closure of Albert Road North exit and entry off St Kilda Road to facilitate line marking
- Local driveway access will be maintained
- Local access will be maintained during these closures. There may be some delays up to 15 minutes to allow line marking to dry and equipment to be moved.

St Kilda Road overnight closure (both directions)

- 11pm Friday 25 October to 8am Saturday 26 October
- Closure of St Kilda Road northbound from Kings Way to Dorcas Street to remove work site barriers
- Closure of St Kilda Road southbound from Southbank Boulevard to Kings Way to remove work site barriers
- St Kilda Road will be closed in both directions during this time, local driveway access will be maintained
- Please follow all traffic signs during this closure.

New southbound lane of St Kilda Road opens

- 8am Saturday 26 October
- Traffic will be diverted onto the newly constructed southbound lane of St Kilda Road.

St Kilda Road southbound closure

- Sunday 27 October, 7am to 9.30am
- Closure of St Kilda Road southbound from Southbank Boulevard to Park Street in order to modify the Dorcas Street traffic signals.

Dorcas Street closure

- Sunday 27 October, 7am to 1pm
- The right turn from Dorcas Street onto St Kilda Road will be closed in order closure to modify the Dorcas Street traffic signal to realignment sequencing.

St Kilda Road overnight closure (both directions)



- Sunday 27 October at 8pm until Monday 28 October at 6am
- Closure of St Kilda Road northbound from Kings Way to Dorcas Street to facilitate line marking works
- Closure of St Kilda Road southbound from Southbank Boulevard to Kings Way to facilitate line marking
- Local access will be maintained at all times, please advise traffic controllers if access is required for your building
- There may be some delays up to 15 minutes to allow line marking to dry and equipment to be moved.

What to be aware of



- Follow detour signs and instructions from traffic controllers
- These works will generate a medium level of noise.
