



WORKS NOTIFICATION

FRANKLIN STREET WESTBOUND LANE OPENING DECEMBER

Major works on the Metro Tunnel are underway to support construction of the new State Library Station at the northern end of Swanston Street in the CBD

The reinstatement of a westbound traffic lane on Franklin Street between Swanston and Stewart streets will now occur from **6am Monday 16 December 2019**.

Swanston Street will also be open to southbound traffic between Victoria and Franklin streets.

What we are doing

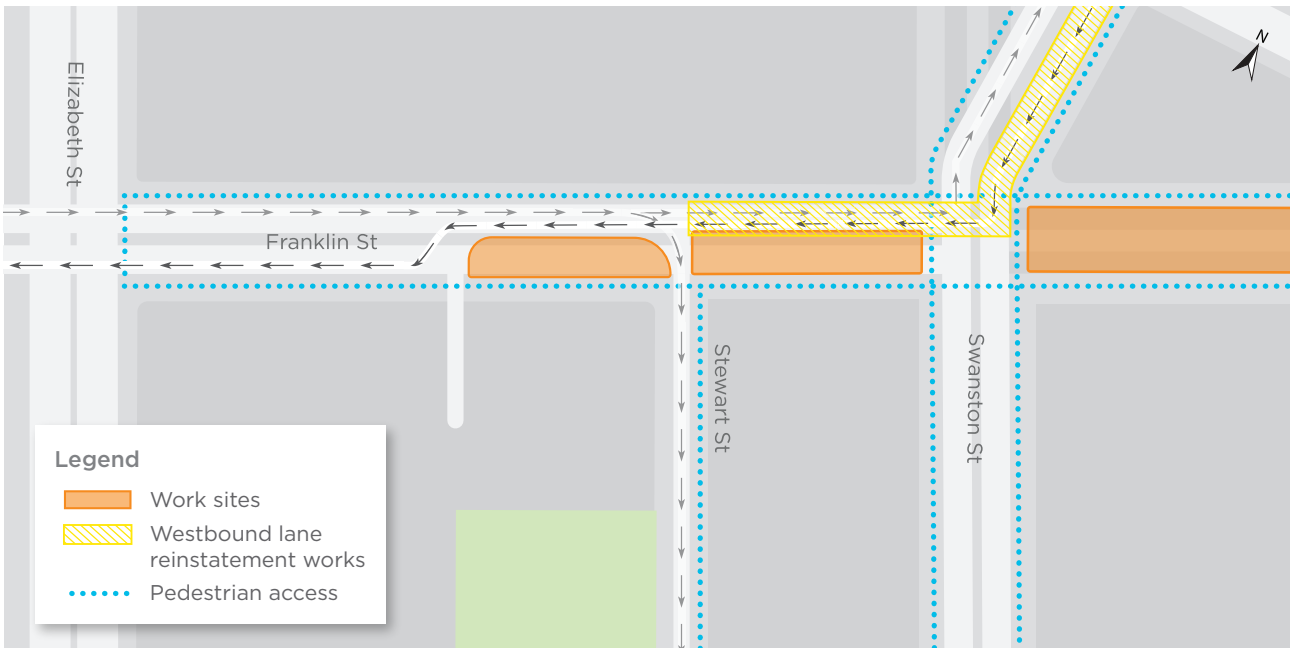
- Works to create a westbound lane adjacent to the northern side of the acoustic shed (which is currently being constructed) involve:
- Line marking using a line marking machine and handheld drill at Victoria Street (near Swanston Street)
- Removing barriers
- Removing and installing signs using a coring machine.

What to be aware of

- Traffic management will be in place to safely guide pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists around the work areas
- The eastbound lane between Stewart and Swanston streets will be closed during these works
- Access to businesses and residential buildings will be maintained at all times
- Works will generate low levels of noise.

When

- Preparatory works: 8pm Sunday 8 December to 5am Monday 9 December and 8pm Sunday 15 December to 5am Monday 16 December
- The westbound lane on Franklin Street (between Swanston and Stewart streets) will reopen to traffic from 6am Monday 16 December.
