Overnight delivery

Toorak Road and William Street, South Yarra

Thursday 5 November 2020

Two piling rigs will be delivered to South Yarra Siding Reserve via Toorak Road and William Street overnight, to complete piling works within the reserve.

What we are doing


- Two piling rigs will be delivered to South Yarra Siding Reserve via Toorak Road and William Street
- The piling rigs will be transported on low-loaders and unloaded in the Siding Reserve
- Oversized deliveries are required to be transported along major arterial roads at night under VicRoads escort to minimise traffic, tram and bus disruptions.

What you should be aware of

- There will be medium levels of noise, with some spikes in high level noise, as the piling rigs are driven out of and into site
- For the safety of workers, there will be some directional lighting used during this time. Every effort will be made to direct all lighting away from homes
- To allow trucks to manoeuvre safely, some parking will be temporarily removed on Toorak Road and William Street.

When

- Parking on Toorak Road and William Street will be unavailable from 6pm on Wednesday, 4 November and will be reinstated by 9am on Thursday, 5 November
- The deliveries will take place between 2am and 5am on Thursday, 5 November.



Health and safety

Metro Tunnel works are progressing safely under the current Second Step restrictions in metropolitan Melbourne.

You may notice an increase of workers on Victoria’s Big Build projects as restrictions on construction sites start to ease. Large-scale public infrastructure projects are critical and strict COVIDsafe Plans are in place on all project sites across Victoria.
