

Works Notification

24-hour rail works Caulfield station

6pm Friday 21 to 10pm Sunday 23 May 2021

Further to the works notification in early May, we wish to advise of 24-hour works while trains are not running to prepare for the installation of a relocatable equipment building (REB) at Caulfield station.

What we are doing

- Installing building foundations, retaining walls, new drainage, cable conduits, signalling and service pits next to the rail lines
- Works will involve the use of an excavator, concrete trucks, crews with hand tools and non-destructive digging to locate any existing underground services and investigate ground conditions
- the REB will be pre-constructed offsite before it is delivered to the site
- Further information about the delivery, installation and internal fit-out of the REB will be provided closer to the date of those works occurring.

24-hour works

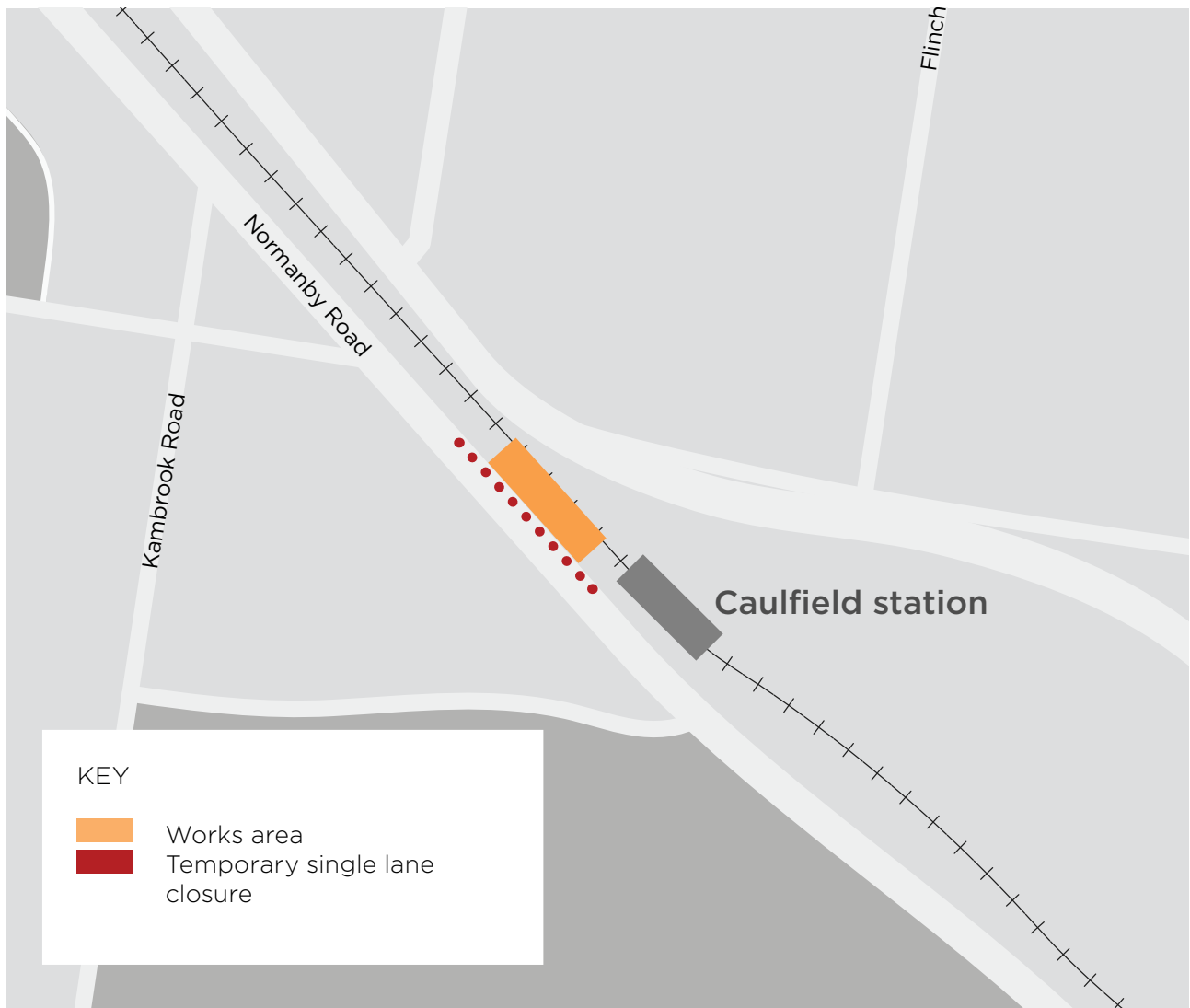
- 6pm Friday 21 to 10pm Sunday 23 May.

Day works

- Ongoing until Friday 4 June
- As previously notified, works will continue to progress during normal construction hours 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday until 4 June.

What you should be aware of

- Works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise and low levels of vibration
- Additional truck movements will be required during the 24-hour works, as materials are delivered to the work site from our rail access point at the car park near Malvern station
- To ensure works are undertaken safely and efficiently, a single lane along Normanby Road will be temporarily unavailable during these times
- Traffic management will be in place along Normanby Road
- Generator-powered lighting towers are required while we complete night works. Where possible, lights will be positioned to face away from residential properties
- Due to other project works also taking place in the rail corridor, buses will be replacing trains on the Frankston/Pakenham lines during this time. Visit ptv.vic.gov.au for more information.
