

# Works Notification

## Extended construction works schedule

Normanby Road, Caulfield

**Monday 2 August to Friday 6 August**

Further to the works notification in early July, we wish to advise preparation works to install the relocatable equipment building (REB) at Caulfield station will be extended until Friday 6 August.

### What we are doing

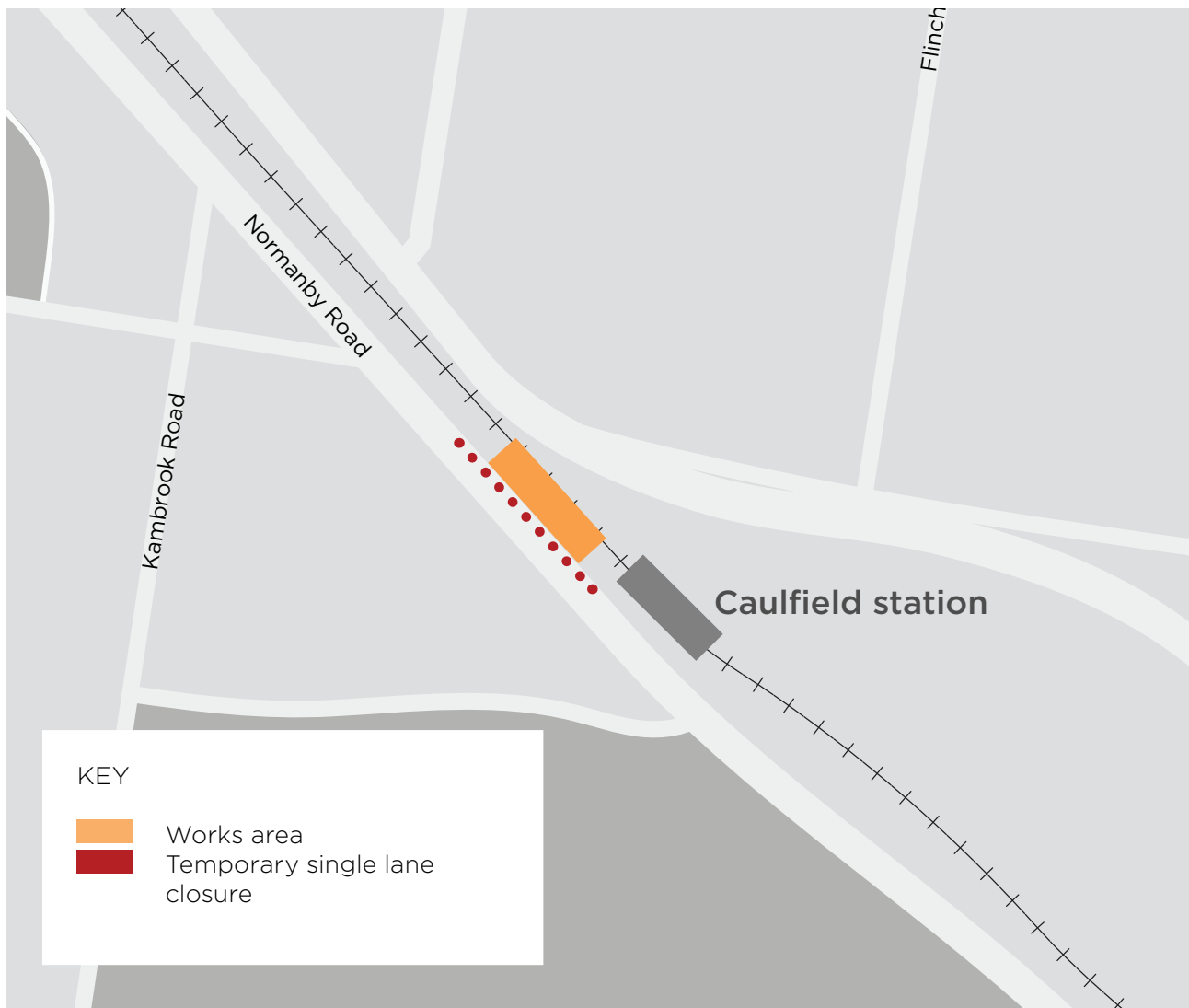
- Installing safety handrails, staircase, fencing and connecting drainage for the future REB
- Works will involve an excavator, a concrete pump, trucks, a non-destructive digging truck to locate any existing underground services without damaging them and crews with handtools
- The REB will be pre-constructed off-site before it is delivered to the site
- Further information about works to deliver and install the REB will be provided closer to the date.

### When

- 7am to 6pm, Monday 2 August to Friday 6 August.

### What you should be aware of

- Works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise
- There will be some additional truck movements to deliver materials to the site while we undertake these works
- To ensure works are undertaken safely and efficiently, a single lane along Normanby Road will be temporarily unavailable during these times
- Traffic management will be in place along Normanby Road to facilitate local traffic
- Power generated light towers may be required during works. Where possible, they will be positioned to face away from residential properties.
