

# Works Notification

## Relocatable equipment building (REB) works

Toorak station, Armadale

October 2021

The internal fit out of the REB located at Toorak station is progressing. Works to connect power from the REB to the existing power supply will commence in October.

### What we are doing

- Removing vegetation including a small tree located within the rail corridor to install a power switchboard that will help power the REB
- Constructing a concrete base slab for the switchboard
- Trenching and connecting electrical power from the REB to the existing power supply
- Works will involve a small excavator, an elevated work platform, a concrete pump, concrete trucks, a non-destructive digging (NDD) truck. NDD uses pressurised water to dig and then vacuum up the soil to expose any existing underground assets and services without damaging them.

### What you should be aware of

- Works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and high-level peaks while the NDD truck and concrete pumps are operating
- Traffic management will be in place to facilitate pedestrian movement
- Temporary on street parking removal along Beatty Avenue will be in place to ensure works are undertaken safe and efficiently
- To avoid any train disruption and ensure the safety of the community, these works will be undertaken outside normal construction hours while trains are not running.

### When

- 10pm and 7am, Monday 11 October to Friday 15 October.



### Health and safety

Works will resume safely from 5 October on the Metro Tunnel with COVID-Safe Plans in place to help protect workers and the community.


Strict processes are in place to check and record the vaccination status of workers entering construction sites.
