



TRAM NETWORK IMPROVEMENT

TRAM POLE AND OVERHEAD WIRE INSTALLATIONS

PARK STREET, SOUTH MELBOURNE

MONDAY, 5 NOVEMBER – THURSDAY, 13 DECEMBER

Works are continuing on Park Street, South Melbourne to install overhead wires for the new Wells Street tram stop (Stop 119).

Construction snapshot

The installation of nine new tram poles was completed in October.

The installation of overhead wires is soon to commence, followed by the removal of redundant poles and reinstatement works.



Overhead wire installation night works

9pm to 5am

Monday, 5 November to Friday, 23 November 2018

These works include:

- The use of an overhead truck with a platform to install overhead wires above the tram line and on to the new poles.

These works are expected to generate low levels of noise.

(These overhead wire works were rescheduled from Sunday, 14 October.)

Traffic changes

During these works, the south side of Park Street will be closed between 53 Park Street and St Kilda Road. Palmerston Crescent will remain open for south-bound traffic crossing from Wells Street. Access to the Hallmark Apartments will be maintained at all times through traffic management.

These changes will only occur overnight and detour routes will be in place (see map overleaf).

Pole removal and reinstatement works

7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday

Wednesday, 28 November to Thursday, 13 December


These works include:

- Removal of redundant poles
- Removal and reinstatement of bluestone kerb
- Resurfacing of road and footpath.

Further notification will be provided to residents ahead of these works.

What to be aware of

- Impacts from construction activities will be managed in accordance with the Metro Tunnel Environmental Performance Requirements
- A small temporary site compound will be located on the footpath near Millers Lane (see map). Pedestrian access will be maintained.
