WORKS NOTIFICATION

24/7 WORKS FOR CABLE INSTALLATION – SURREY, CROMWELL AND LUXTON ROADS **FRIDAY 14 TO SUNDAY 16 JUNE 2019**

As previously notified, after hours works will be taking place in your area from Friday 14 to Sunday 16 June as part of the Metro Tunnel Project. During this time additional works are required to complete cable installation on the Surrey and Cromwell Road bridges and along the rail corridor on Luxton Road near Hawksburn station.

What we are doing

Surrey Road

- Installing galvanized piping along the side of the Surrey Road bridge using an elevated work platform and hand tools
- The pipe will be fixed and then bolted onto the bridge, so that cabling can be installed at a later date.

Cromwell Road

- Completing excavation and piling works from the Cromwell bridge into the rail corridor below
- Concrete pouring and cable installation works using hand tools, an excavator and piling drill.

Luxton Road

- Excavation and trenching works to install cable conduit along the rail corridor
- An excavator and hand tools will be in use.

When

- 24/7 works, beginning after the last passenger service on Friday and finishing before the first passenger service on Sunday
- These works are required to take place while the rail lines are shut down to ensure the safety of our workers.

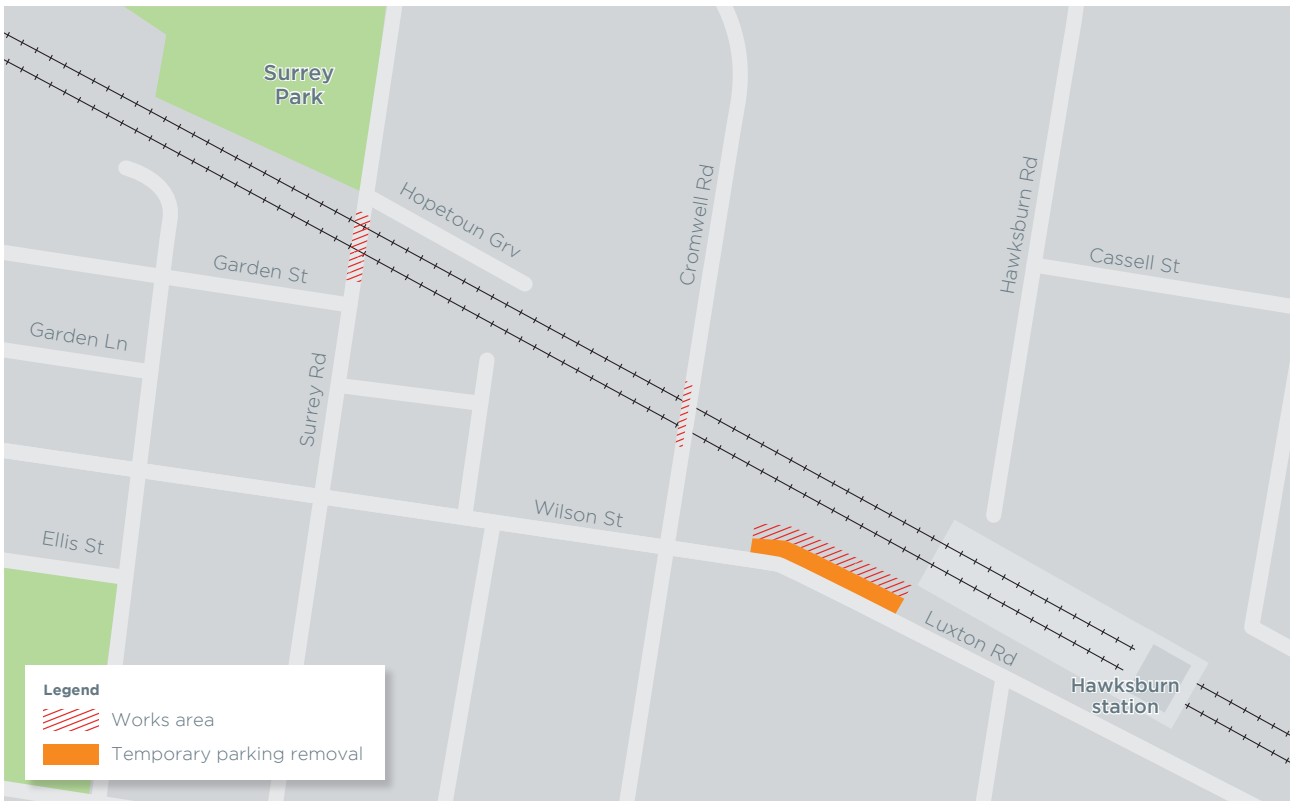
What to be aware of

Traffic impacts

- Surrey, Cromwell and Luxton roads will operate under traffic management while these works are being completed
- There will be approximately four parking spaces temporarily removed on Luxton Road, near Hawksburn station. Please see map overleaf for locations.





Construction impacts

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise, with some periods of high-level noise
- These works will be completed under directional lighting to ensure the safety of our workers. Every effort will be made to direct these lights away from homes
- Additional truck movements will be required as dirt and spoil are removed from the rail corridor
- Please note that the High Capacity Metro Trains project will also be working in the area during this time. Visit transport.vic.gov.au for more information about the High Capacity Metro Trains project.
