



WORKS NOTIFICATION

SWANSTON STREET DRIVEWAY WORKS JUNE 30 - JULY 24 2019

Major construction is continuing in the CBD at the site of the future Town Hall Station, to enable construction of a vehicle egress from the City Square site onto Swanston Street. During this time, there will be changes to the Swanston Street pedestrian footpath, between Collins Street and Flinders Lane.

What we are doing

Sunday 30 June until Thursday 4 July 8pm to 7am

- Installing barriers on the Swanston Street footpath to create a delineated work area
- Demolishing a kerb and road traffic island
- Asphaltting within the work area
- Pavement removal using an excavator with a hammer attachment
- Works will take place at night to minimise impacts to pedestrians and local businesses.

Friday 5 July until Sunday 21 July, 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, 7am to 1pm Saturdays

- Installing a roller door
- Asphaltting and minor civil works to construct the new driveway.

Tuesday 23 July until Wednesday 24 July 8pm to 7am

- Final asphaltting works on footpath.

Pedestrian impacts

- The east west pedestrian crossing at the Swanston Street and Flinders Lane intersection will be closed from 30 June until 4 July (refer to map)
- The Flinders Lane pedestrian crossing between City Square and St Paul's Cathedral will be closed for two nights between 8pm and 7am on Sunday 30 June and Thursday 4 July
- Once the night works are completed the pedestrian crossing will be realigned to enable space for a long term driveway egress from late July 2019 (refer to map)
- Access to tram stop 11 will be maintained at all times.

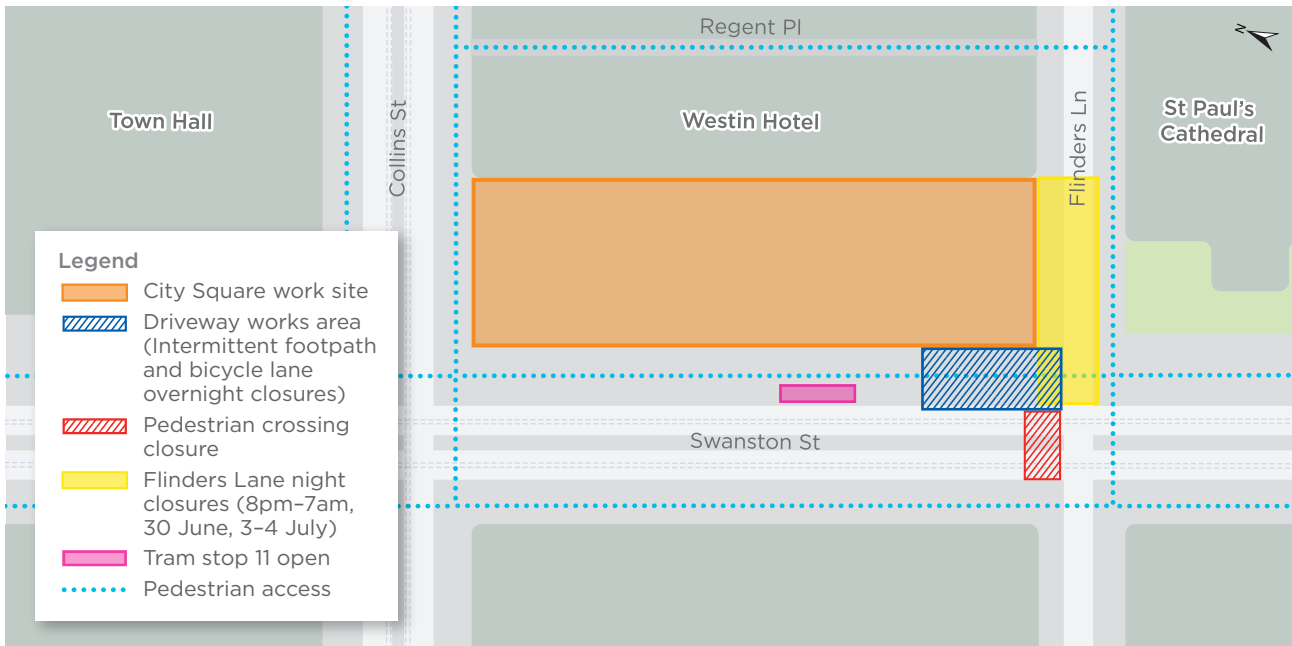
Cyclist impacts

- The southbound cyclist lane between Collins Street and Flinders lane will be closed between 1am and 5am on the nights of Monday 1 and Tuesday 2 July.

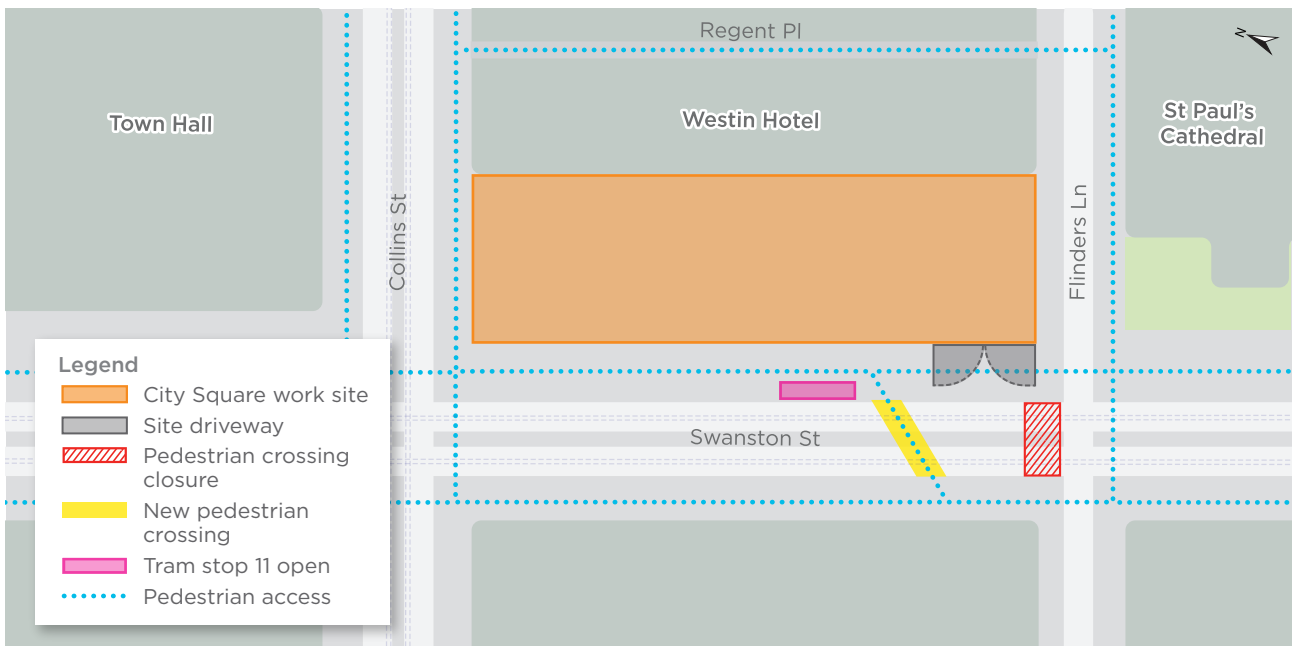
Motorist impacts

- Flinders Lane will be closed between 8pm and 7am on Sunday 30 June and from Wednesday 3 to Thursday 4 July.
