



## WORKS NOTIFICATION

### 24/7 RAIL MAINTENANCE WORKS RAIL CORRIDOR, BETWEEN HAWKSburn AND MALVERN STATIONS

**THURSDAY 18 TO TUESDAY 23 JUNE 2020**

As part of the Metro Tunnel works to construct the eastern tunnel entrance in South Yarra, we will be undertaking rail infrastructure upgrades and maintenance works along the rail corridor between Hawksburn and Malvern stations.

#### What we are doing

- Service investigations using non-destructive digging (NDD) trucks
- NDD uses pressurised water to break up and vacuum soil to expose assets and services located underground without damaging them
- Maintenance works on previously installed rail infrastructure
- Installing cable conduits along Osment Street involving the use of excavators, drills and crews with hand tools.

#### When

##### Rail corridor works (24/7 works)

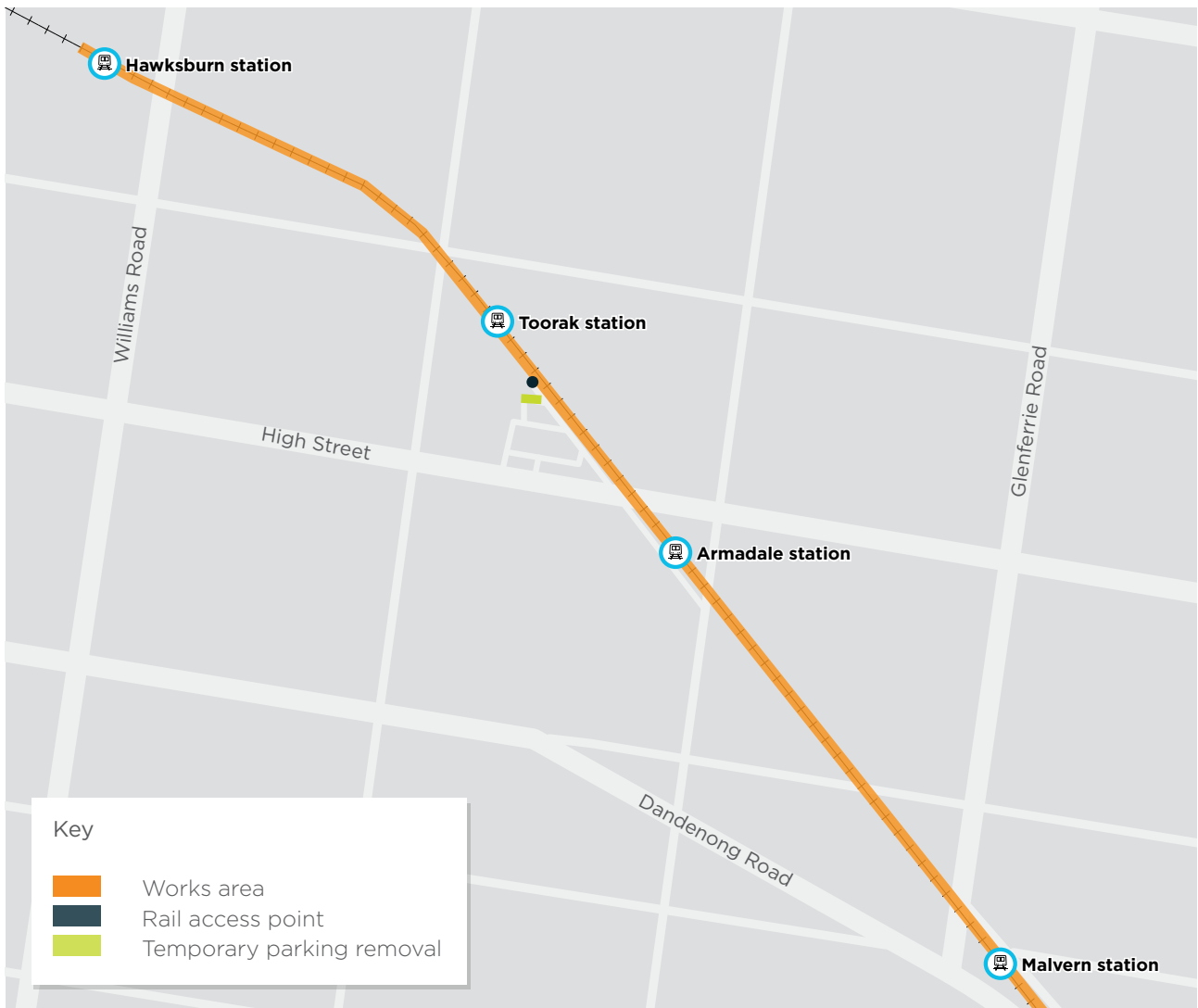
- 10pm Friday 19 June to 3am Monday 22 June.

##### Parking removal on Osment Street

- Thursday 18 to Tuesday 23 June.

#### What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise, with some high level peaks
- Traffic management will be in place and some parking will also be temporarily removed along Osment Street to allow for safe access to the work sites. Access for vehicles will be maintained during this time
- Generator-powered lighting towers are required during nightworks within the rail corridor. Where possible, they will be positioned to face away from residential properties
- Due to other project works also taking place in the rail corridor, buses will be replacing trains on the Frankston line from Friday 19 to Monday 22 June. Visit [www.ptv.vic.gov.au](http://www.ptv.vic.gov.au) for more information.
