

# Works notification

## Station entrance construction preparatory works Grattan Street west and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade, Parkville

**From 1 February to late March 2021**

To construct the future station entrance adjacent to The Royal Melbourne Hospital, preparatory works are required on Grattan Street west and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade.

Following completion of the first stage of station entrance construction adjacent to the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre in 2020, construction of the Metro Tunnel's new Parkville Station is moving into the next phase. Preparatory works will now commence to enable construction of the station entrance adjacent to The Royal Melbourne Hospital.

### What we are doing

- Relocating services, and the removal of redundant services. This will involve saw-cutting, non-destructive digging (NDD), excavation, backfilling and reinstatement, depending on the work activity and location
- Widening the existing pedestrian crossing on the southern side of the Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade and Grattan Street intersection
- Modifying kerbs at the Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade and Grattan Street intersection, and on Grattan Street between Flemington Road and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade to create pedestrian ramps
- Installing a pedestrian safety fence on Royal Parade due to upcoming pedestrian changes
- Removing and relocating street furniture
- Constructing a future site access point on Royal Parade.

### What to be aware of

- Work will be staged in various locations around the site at Grattan Street west and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade during this time
- There will be intermittent closures of Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade northbound and southbound lanes. Access for vehicles travelling northbound from or southbound to Haymarket Roundabout will be maintained
- Traffic management and signage will be in place to communicate and safely direct vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians around the work areas during closures
- Access will be maintained for emergency services, and to businesses, hospitals, hospital car park and drop-off/pick-up areas
- Works may be scheduled out of hours due to the proximity to tram services, to avoid disruption to public transport services, or to minimise impacts to the road network
- During works in the Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade northbound service lane, the bus route 505 will not service The Royal Melbourne Hospital/Royal Parade stop. Passengers are advised to use the alternative bus stop at Morrah Street/Royal Parade located 250 metres north on Royal Parade
- There are no expected impacts to Yarra Tram services

- Localised pedestrian diversions will be in place as required
- Depending on the work activity, these works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise.

### When

- 24 hours, Monday to Sunday, depending on the work activity.
