

Works Notification

24-hour rail works

Rail Corridor between South Yarra and Windsor stations

7pm Friday 26 to 3am Monday 29 March 2021

As part of the Metro Tunnel works to construct the eastern tunnel entrance in South Yarra, we will require 24-hour access to the rail corridor via Greville and Union streets to deliver materials to work sites while trains are not running.

What we are doing

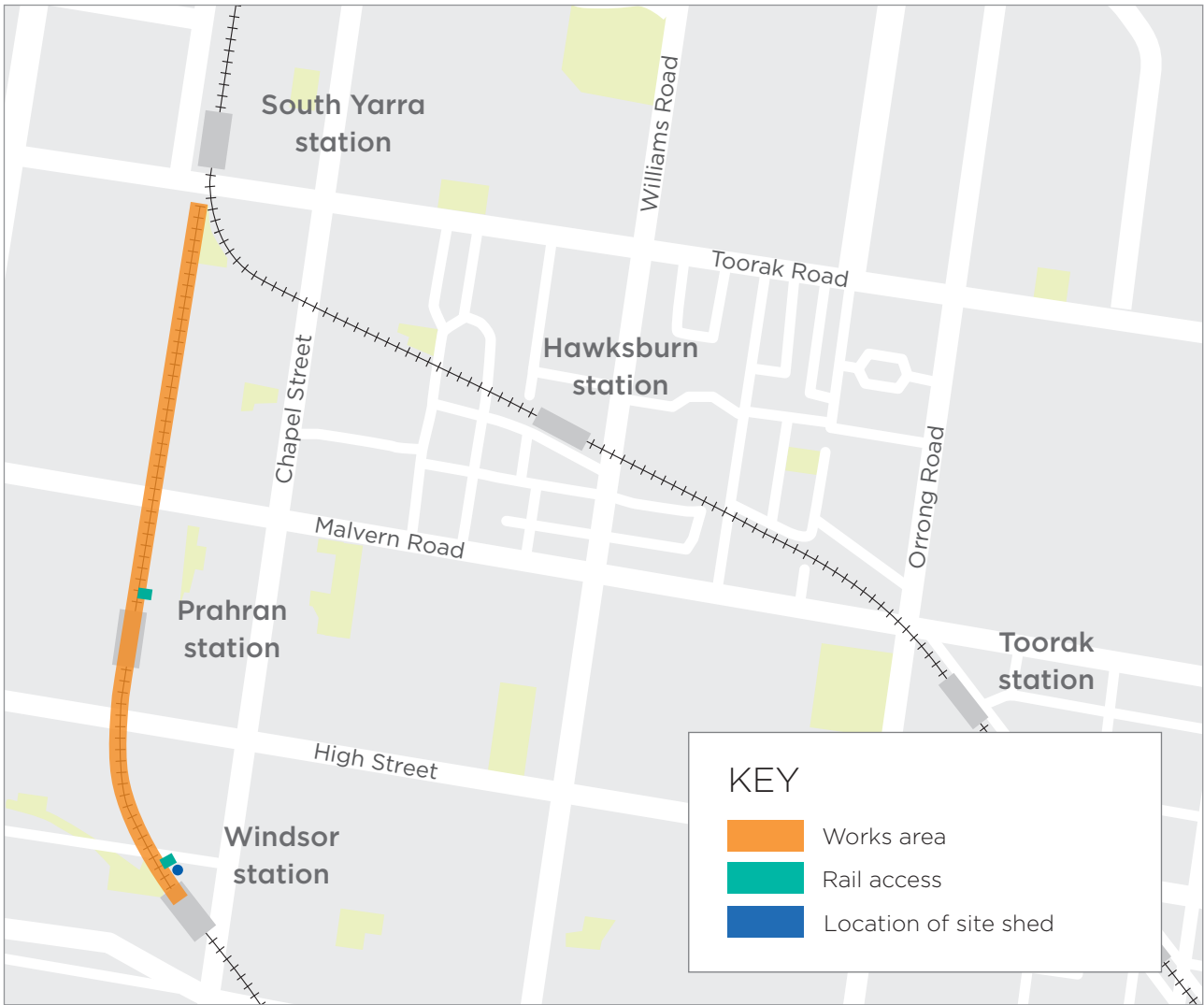
- Delivering rail equipment and materials via the rail access points at Greville and Union streets to work sites near the South Yarra Siding Reserve
- Establishing a temporary site shed on vacant land near Union Street next to the rail lines, to provide essential worker amenities while we complete works
- Installing signalling cables along the rail corridor between South Yarra and Windsor stations. Works will involve the use of a cable truck and crews with hand tools.

When

- 7pm Friday 26 to 3am Monday 29 March.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise
- Additional truck movements will be required as materials are delivered from the rail access points at Greville and Union streets to work sites
- Traffic management will be in place along Greville and Union streets while we complete works on the rail corridor. Access to nearby business and residential properties will be maintained
- Generator-powered lighting towers are required while we complete night works. Where possible, lights will be positioned to face away from residential properties and noise reduction mats will be placed around generators
- Due to other project works also taking place in the rail corridor, buses will be replacing trains on the Sandringham line during this time. Visit ptv.vic.gov.au for more information.
