Underground service investigations

Osment Street, Armadale

Tuesday 3 to Tuesday 10 August 2021

As part of Metro Tunnel wider corridor work, underground service investigation works and installation of service pits will take place on Osment Street.

What we are doing

- Non-destructive digging (NDD) to investigate existing underground services and installing rail service pits
- NDD uses high-pressure water to dig the ground without damaging any existing underground services
- This activity will require the use of a NDD truck and crews with hand tools.

When

- Tuesday 3 to Tuesday 10 August
- Weekdays only, 7am to 6pm.

What you should be aware of

- This activity is expected to generate medium levels of noise with some high-level peaks
- Some parking along Osment Street will be temporarily unavailable to allow works to be undertaken safely and efficiently during this time
- Traffic management will be in place along Osment Street to safely facilitate vehicles movements. Vehicle and pedestrian access to local businesses and residential properties will be maintained during this time.
