

Works Notification

24-hour rail corridor works

Between South Yarra and Caulfield stations

Friday 27 August to Monday 30 August

As part of works to connect the new Metro Tunnel to the existing eastern corridor rail lines, we will undertake 24-hour works within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations while trains are not running.

What we are doing

Rail corridor works

- Constructing overhead structure foundations, installing overhead structures, signalling cable assets, retaining walls, underground cable services and conduits within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) is required to locate and expose underground services. NDD uses pressurised water to dig and then vacuum up the soil to expose assets and services underground without damaging them
- Works will require the use of elevated work platforms, generators, an NDD truck, cranes, excavators, concrete pumps and crews with hand tools.

What to be aware of

Light and noise impacts

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise with some high-level peaks. Where possible, higher impact works will be scheduled to take place during the day
- Generator-powered lighting towers are required while we complete night works. Where possible, lights will be positioned to face away from residential properties and noise reduction mats will be placed around generators.

Traffic impacts and bus replacements

- Additional truck movements will be required during the 24-hour rail works. Materials will be delivered to work sites from our laydown sites
- Due to other project works taking place in the rail corridor, buses will be replacing trains on the Frankston/Dandenong lines from Friday 27 August to Monday 30 August. Visit ptv.vic.gov.au for more information

Edward Street and Evelina Road, Toorak

- Temporary parking and road closures will be in place along Edward Street and a section of Evelina Road to ensure rail materials are delivered safely and efficiently through the rail access point
- Traffic management will be in place to help facilitate local vehicle and pedestrian movement and access to residential properties will not be impacted
- Detailed information about these temporary traffic changes will be distributed closer to the date.

Kooyong Road, Osment Street and Inverness Avenue, Armadale

- Some parking along Osment Street and Inverness Avenue will be temporarily unavailable while we undertake works within the rail corridor
- Traffic management will be in place to help facilitate local vehicle and pedestrian movement and access to residential properties will not be impacted
- Detailed information about these temporary traffic changes will be distributed closer to the date.







Wilson Street, South Yarra

- Some parking on Wilson Street will be temporarily unavailable while we undertake works within the rail corridor
- Traffic management will be in place to help facilitate local vehicle and pedestrian movement and access to residential properties will not be impacted.

Malvern Woodyard, Malvern Station, Station Street and Dandenong Road, Malvern

- Additional truck movements will be required at the Malvern Woodyard and along Dandenong Road as we deliver materials to the rail corridor. Some parking near Malvern Station will be unavailable to facilitate these movements
- A single lane on Dandenong Road and some parking on Station Street will be temporarily

- closed to assist with activities undertaken within the rail corridor during 24-hour works
- Traffic management will be in place to help facilitate local vehicle and pedestrian movement and access to businesses and residential properties will not be impacted.


Health and safety
