



WORKS NOTIFICATION

GRATTAN STREET WEST SERVICE INVESTIGATIONS, PARKVILLE PRECINCT FROM 2 APRIL - MAY 2019

Major works on the Metro Tunnel are underway in Parkville to build the new underground station. The next phase of construction involves underground service investigations on Grattan Street and Royal Parade.

These underground service investigations are required before service relocations take place from mid-2019 and construction begins on two new station entrances next year.

What we are doing

- Investigation of underground utility services on the west side of Grattan Street between Royal Parade and Flemington Road and on Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade
- This involves confirming and identifying the location of underground utility services including on the footpath and road in Grattan Street and Royal Parade
- Works will involve saw cutting and non-destructive digging (NDD) to expose the underground service and verify its location and reinstating the footpath or road.

What to be aware of


- There will be temporary, staged lane closures including on:
 - Grattan Street between Flemington Road and Royal Parade
 - Northbound service lane on Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade between Haymarket Roundabout and just north of the Royal Melbourne Hospital.
- Vehicle and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times with diversions in place

- Plan ahead and allow extra travel time
- Where possible, lane closures will occur outside of peak periods
- There will be times when parking bays on Grattan Street and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade and drop off bays along Grattan Street will need to be temporarily occupied for short periods during the works. Further information including dates will be provided
- Access to hospitals, including for emergency services, and to businesses will be maintained at all times
- Temporary fencing and signage will be installed around the work sites to ensure the safety of the community and workers
- There will be no changes to bus or tram services during these works
- These works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise during NDD and saw cutting works
- All works will be completed in line with the Metro Tunnel Project Environmental Performance Requirements (EPRs).


When
