

WORKS NOTIFICATION

OUT OF HOURS WORKS KENSINGTON

JULY

This notification provides information about upcoming out of hours works in Kensington. These works will take place adjacent to South Kensington station.

What we are doing

Fencing works

- Installation of delineation fencing to separate our worksite from the rail corridor, involving two small excavators to dig fence post holes
- These works have been rescheduled from dates included in the July Construction Update.

Site investigations

- Excavating a series of small pits within the rail corridor to understand ground conditions
- Geotechnical drilling to identify ground conditions to help inform detailed planning.

Drainage works

- Installing temporary drainage pipes underneath Childers Street requiring a closure of Childers Street for two days
- These works involve saw cutting the road, using an excavator and a non-destructive digging truck (NDD) to dig a trench; then installing crushed rock, concrete pits and pipes.

Piling pad works

• Earthworks, including use of a vibrating roller to construct sections of the piling pad.

Fencing works

- 12am to 5am, Tuesday 23 July
- 12am to 5am, Wednesday 24 July.

Site investigations

- 1pm to 6pm, Saturday 20 July
- 8am to 6pm, Sunday 21 July.

Drainage works

- 7am to 6pm, Monday 15 July to Friday 19 July (normal working hours)
- 7am to 6pm, Saturday 20 July
- 8am to 6pm, Sunday 21 July
- 7am to 6pm, Monday 22 July to Friday 26 July (normal working hours).

Piling pad works

• 1pm Saturday 3 August to 6pm, Sunday 4 August.






What to be aware of

- To ensure the safety of passengers and our workers, activities located close to the rail corridor can only be performed safely when trains are not operating
- Geotechnical drilling will involve the use of a sonic drilling machine, generating low to medium levels of noise and low levels of vibration
- Fencing works will generate periods of high level noise during NDD works
- Use of light towers will be required during evening and night works. We will position lights so they face away from residential properties, where possible.

Traffic changes

- Over-height vehicles accessing the Lloyd Street business estate will be required to detour via Kensington Road, Derby Street and Tennyson Street for drainage works from 7am to 6pm, Wednesday 24 August to Thursday 25 August
- Signage and traffic controllers will be in place to direct vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians in the area.
