TUNNEL BORING MACHINE DELIVERIES

15 DECEMBER - 17 DECEMBER 2019

As outlined in the November and December construction notification, deliveries are continuing to arrive in Domain in preparation to assemble the two tunnel boring machines (TBMs).

TBM deliveries are classed as oversized and therefore must be delivered in the early morning to minimise impacts on the road and tram networks. The next oversized deliveries are expected to arrive on trucks over two nights, after 1am on 16 and 17 of December.

What we are doing

- On Sunday 15 December a 250-tonne mobile crane will be erected onsite in preparation to unload the deliveries. The crane will arrive in six trailer loads
- Lifts using this crane will take place on Sunday for testing
- In the early morning of Monday 16 and Tuesday 17 December parts of the TBM will arrive to site
- Unlike the previous TBM deliveries that arrived on site and parked for unloading after 7am,

the trucks required for delivering these parts will need to be unloaded by crane on arrival, as they are too large to remain on site.

What to be aware of



- There will be some periods of noise during the early morning on Monday and Tuesday
- The crane required to unload the TBM pieces will be set up during the day on Sunday prior to the deliveries arriving
- St Kilda Road will be closed between 1am and 5am on 16 and 17 December to facilitate these oversized deliveries.

When

- **Sunday 15 December, 7am - 6pm**
- **Monday 16 and Tuesday 17 December, 1am - 7am.**
