

Works Notification

Site establishment

402 - 416 Chapel Street, South Yarra

4 February to mid-December 2021

To support works to connect the new Metro Tunnel to the existing eastern corridor rail lines, we are establishing a laydown area to store materials and equipment on the vacant land at 402 - 416 Chapel Street, South Yarra.

What we are doing

This site will be used during 2021 for delivery and storage of rail equipment and materials, worker amenities and construction vehicle parking.

Site establishment

- Delivering and compacting ballast (crushed rock) to provide a safe surface within the site. This will also reduce dust and dirt being spread from the site
- Delivering and storing construction material and equipment
- Establishing an area for vehicle parking
- Installing a temporary site shed, fencing, worker amenities and light towers.

Site use

- Once established, the site will be used for delivery and storage of rail infrastructure, machinery and equipment. The site will not be used to store materials such as soil and crushed rock.

When

Site establishment

- Thursday 4 to Friday 19 February
- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday.

Site use

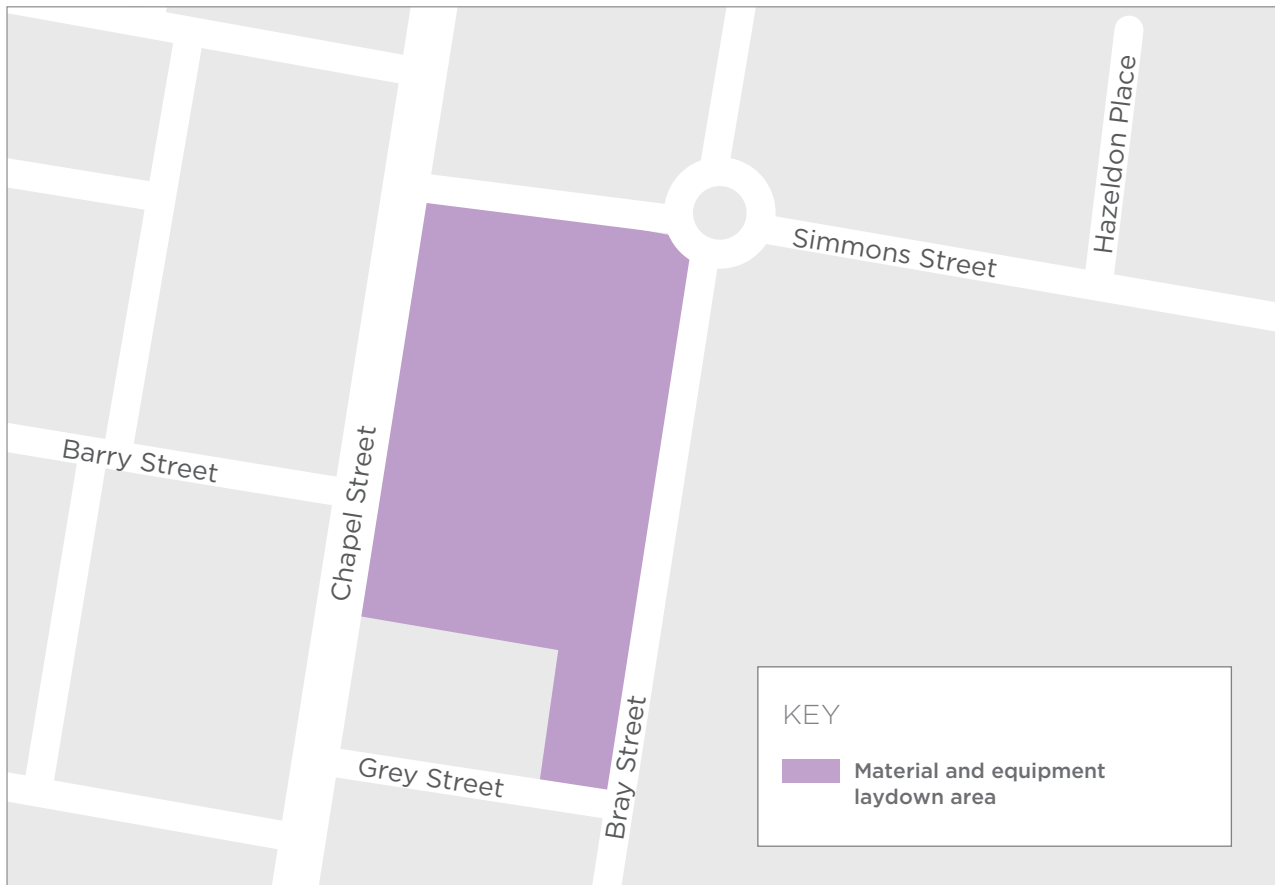
- Monday 15 February to mid-December
- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 7am to 1pm, Saturdays, unless otherwise notified
- The site will be used to support some out of hours works, including a number of weekend periods of 24-hour access during rail shutdowns throughout 2021.

Health and safety

Works on the Metro Tunnel project are progressing with strict COVIDsafe plans in place.

The health and safety of our workforce and community remains our top priority.

What you should be aware of

- These works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise during site establishment. Medium levels of vibration may be observed as the site surface is compacted
- Periods of 24-hour site use during rail shutdowns during 2021
- Additional truck movements will be required as materials are delivered to site and throughout the rail corridor
- Residents and businesses will be notified prior to the site being used for out of hours work
- Low to medium noise levels are expected during periods of 24-hour access
- Temporary light towers may be required to be used during this time. Where possible, they will be positioned to face away from residential properties
- Security guards will be present on site 24/7 to protect equipment and materials and discourage trespassing.
